

BUILDING UTILIZATION PLAN

INTRODUCTION

As described in greater detail in the attached Educational Impact Statement ("EIS"), the New York City Department of Education ("DOE") is proposing to co-locate Uncommon Charter High School 3, a charter high school, in building K515 ("K515") at 6565 Flatlands Avenue, Brooklyn, NY, 11236, in Community School District 18 ("District 18") beginning in 2014-2015.¹ K515 currently houses Brooklyn Generation School (18K566, "Brooklyn Generation"), an existing district high school serving ninth through twelfth grades; Brooklyn Theatre Arts High School (18K567, "Brooklyn Theatre Arts"), an existing district high school serving ninth through twelfth grades; Victory Collegiate High School (18K576, "Victory Collegiate"), an existing district high school serving ninth through twelfth grades; Brooklyn Bridge Academy (18K578), an existing district transfer high school serving ninth through twelfth grades; Academy for Conservation and the Environment (18K637), an existing district high school serving ninth through twelfth grades and a General Educational Development Plus program² (79Q950, "GED Plus"), a Citywide program designed to help students earn their GEDs and prepare them for college and career options and a Young Adult Borough Center ("YABC" "18K922")³.

Once it is fully phased in, Uncommon Charter High School 3 will serve students in grades nine through twelve and will only enroll students who have been promoted from a charter middle school operated by Uncommon Schools ("Uncommon"), the Charter Management Organization ("CMO") that will also manage Uncommon Charter High School 3. The charter middle schools that will feed into Uncommon Charter High School 3 beginning in the 2014-2015 school year are: Brooklyn East Collegiate Charter School, located in District 13 (84K780, "Brooklyn East Collegiate"), Ocean Hill Collegiate, located in District 23 (84K777, "Ocean Hill Collegiate"), and Leadership Prep Bedford Stuyvesant Charter School, located in District 13 (84K517, "Leadership Prep Bedford Stuyvesant").

On December 14, 2011, the Panel for Educational Policy ("PEP") approved the co-location of Uncommon Charter High School 2 in building K458 in District 13. The proposal for this co-location described that four charter middle schools, managed by Uncommon Schools, would feed into Uncommon Charter High School 2: Bedford Stuyvesant Collegiate Charter School (84K648, "Bedford Stuyvesant Collegiate Charter"), Brownsville Collegiate Charter School (84K710, "Brownsville Collegiate"), Ocean Hill Collegiate (84K777 "Ocean Hill Collegiate ") and Brooklyn East Collegiate Charter School (84K780, "Brooklyn East Collegiate"). Ocean Hill Collegiate and Brooklyn East Collegiate were to begin feeding into Uncommon Charter High School 2 during the 2014-2015 school year. Uncommon Schools has informed the DOE that it now plans to serve its students from Ocean Hill Collegiate and Brooklyn East Collegiate, at Uncommon High School 3 instead of Uncommon High School 2. As such, if this proposal is approved, beginning in 2014-2015, Ocean Hill Collegiate and Brooklyn East Collegiate students who are enrolled in an Uncommon Schools managed high school will be served in K515 and not K458.

Pursuant to the New York State Charter Schools Act of 1998 (as amended May 2010), the following plan outlines the proposed allocation of classrooms and administrative space between Brooklyn Generation, Brooklyn Theatre Arts, Victory Collegiate, Brooklyn Bridge Academy, Academy for Conservation and the Environment, Uncommon Charter High School 3 and GED Plus . It also includes a proposal for the collaborative usage of shared resources and spaces during the 2014-2015 year between Brooklyn Generation, Brooklyn Theatre Arts, Victory Collegiate, Brooklyn Bridge Academy, Academy for Conservation and the Environment, Uncommon Charter High School 3, and GED Plus, including, but not limited to, cafeterias, libraries, and gymnasiums, to assure equitable access to such facilities. If a school's baseline allocation under the Citywide Instructional Footprint ("Footprint") declines, those rooms may be re-allocated to another co-

located school.⁴ Information about the impact on building safety and security, proposed strategies for communication and collaborative decision-making between the co-located schools, and a description of the shared space committee is also included. Please refer to the EIS, to which this plan is attached, for further information about the proposed co-location.

As described throughout this document, the final shared space schedule will be collaboratively finalized by the Building Council if the proposed co-location is approved by the Panel for Educational Policy.

METHODOLOGY

The DOE has applied the Footprint to all schools and/or programs outlined in this plan to allocate rooms in an unbiased manner, and has divided the remaining space equitably based on the proportion of the total students in the building enrolled by each school and/or program, the instructional and programmatic needs of the co-located schools, and the physical location of the excess space within the building.

JUSTIFICATION OF FEASIBILITY AND EQUITABILITY OF CLASSROOM AND ADMINISTRATIVE SPACE ALLOCATION

The Footprint sets forth the baseline number of rooms that should be allocated to a school based on the grade levels served by the school and number of classes per grade. For existing schools, the Footprint is applied to the current number of classes and class sizes a school has programmed and is confirmed by a walk-through of the building by a representative of the Office of Space Planning and a representative of the school. For elementary schools serving grades K-5 and for pre-kindergarten programs, the Footprint assumes that classes are self-contained (“SC”), meaning that each class remains in its homeroom throughout the day except for when it is scheduled for a cluster activity (for example, art) or lunch, recess, etc. Further, the Footprint assumes that at those times the homeroom classroom remains empty. Therefore, the Footprint allocates one full-size classroom for each general education (“GE”) or Integrated Co-Teaching section (“ICT”) and a full-size or half-size classroom to accommodate each SC special education section served by the school. In addition, schools serving grades K-5 receive an allocation of cluster or specialty classrooms proportionate to the number of students enrolled. These classrooms can be used at the principal’s discretion for purposes such as art and/or music instruction, among other things.

At the elementary level, cluster classrooms are allocated as follows:

⁴ The Footprint is a tool to be used by all stakeholders in the analysis and assessment of space usage in DOE buildings. Its purpose is to ensure that the space allocation plan for all schools is fair and equitable. In co-location agreements, the parameters outlined in the Footprint should serve as a guideline for making decisions about the allocation of space, while empowering building occupants to make decisions that best meet the needs of all students in the building. For grades 6-12, the Footprint assumes that students move from class to class and that classrooms should be programmed at maximum efficiency. The Footprint does not require that every teacher have his or her own designated classroom. Principals are asked to program their schools efficiently so that classrooms can be used for multiple purposes throughout the course of the school day.

The Footprint allocates the number of baseline full-size equivalent ("FSE") classrooms for student support services, resource rooms, and administrative space based on the grades a school serves and its enrollment at scale.

While the Footprint sets forth a baseline space allocation, school leaders are empowered to make decisions about how to utilize the space allocated to the school. Therefore, each principal must make decisions about how and where students will be served within the space allocated to the school. The DOE, however, will provide support to the schools to ensure that the schools use the space efficiently in order to maximize capacity to support student needs and maintain appropriate delivery of special education and related services to students. Where appropriate, school leaders will have an opportunity to draw upon the expertise and guidance of the Office of Special Education, which is dedicated to promoting positive educational outcomes for students with disabilities.

Allocation of Classrooms and Administrative Space

According to a building walkthrough and survey performed on July 18, 2012 by a representative of the Office of Space Planning, K515 has a total of 149 full-size ("FS") classrooms/spaces,⁵ 14 half-size ("HS") classrooms/spaces,⁶ and 30.5 FSE of designed administrative office space. K515 also contains 2 gymnasiums, 1 auditorium, 2 cafeterias, and library. The below spaces are shared spaces or contain building services and will not be included in the allocation of space for an individual school:

The following are shared spaces being used by students:

- The music room occupies 2 full-size spaces.
- A science lab shared by Victory Collegiate and Brooklyn Generation occupies 1 full-size space.
- The dance room occupies 1 full-size space.
- The home economics room occupies 1 full-size space.
- The weight room occupies 1 full-size space.
- Two miscellaneous classrooms are being shared by Victory Collegiate and Brooklyn Generation occupying 2 full -size spaces.

The following are shared spaces currently being used for shared administrative space:

- Offices occupy 8.5 FSE of designed administrative space and 1 half-size space.
- The parent coordinator's office occupies 1 half-size space.
- The campus dean's office occupies 1 half-size space.
- A storage room occupies 1 full-size space.
- An assistant principal's office occupies 1 full-size space.
- The building council's conference room occupies 1 full-size space.
- The nurse's office occupies 1.0 FSE of designed administrative space.

⁵ Full-size classrooms have an area of 500 square feet or more.

⁶ Half-size classrooms have an area of less than 500 square feet but greater than 239 square feet.

- The custodian's office occupies 1 half-size space and 1.0 FSE of designed administrative space.
- The School Based Support Team occupies 2.0 FSE of designed administrative space
- School Safety occupies 8 full-size spaces and 1.0 FSE of designed administrative space.
- The athletic coaches' offices occupy 1 full-size room, 2 half-size rooms and 1.0 FSE of designed administrative space.
- The New York Police Department occupies 1 full-size space.
- A principal's office occupies 1.0 FSE of designed administrative space
- Building Support is currently occupying 3.0 FSE of designed administrative space
- The record room occupies 2 full-size spaces.

The following are specially designed rooms not currently being used by the co-located schools

- The auto shops occupy 2 full-size spaces.
- The wood shops occupy 2 full-size spaces.
- Two other shop rooms occupy 2 full-size spaces.

Excluding the spaces outlined above, K515 has a total of 120 full-size classrooms/spaces, 8 half-size classrooms/spaces, 0 quarter-size spaces, and 12.0 FSE of designed administrative office spaces remaining that can be allocated to schools.

Shared Space Plan

A proposed Shared Space plan for the 2014-2015 school year is below. The following plan is based on the estimated duration of time each of the co-located schools will have in each of the shared spaces in K515. The final shared space schedule will be collaboratively drafted by the Building Council if the proposed co-locations are approved by the PEP.

JUSTIFICATION OF FEASIBILITY AND EQUITY OF PROPOSED SHARED SPACE PLAN

This proposed Shared Space Plan is based upon the population size and other relevant factors further described below for each co-located school. Although the DOE has proposed how the shared spaces in the building may be utilized, Building Councils are free to deviate from the proposed Shared Space Plan to accommodate specific programmatic needs of all special populations or groups within each school as is feasible and equitable, provided that the Building Council comes to an agreement of the final Shared Space Plan collaboratively. (NOTE: The Building Council will revisit the Shared Space Plan and its schedules on an annual basis to account for any changes in enrollment or programmatic needs. If conflicts emerge and progress is impaired, the Building Council will follow the dispute resolution procedures outlined in the Campus Policy Memo available at the following link: <http://schools.nyc.gov/community/campusgov>.)

As of 2013-2014 GED Plus does not use any of the shared spaces in K515. The below shared space plan for 2014-2015 therefore, does not allocate use of any of the shared spaces in the attached shared space plan to GED Plus. Any changes or modifications to usage of shared space in K515 will be decided by the Building Council.

The below proposed schedule is based on projected enrollments for Uncommon Charter High School 3 , Brooklyn Generation, Brooklyn Theatre Arts, Victory Collegiate, Brooklyn Bridge Academy, and Academy for Conservation and the Environment's current space allocations and lunch schedule as described on the DOE School Food website,²⁰ the total capacity of each shared space, the grades served by each of the co-located schools, and the start and end times of Brooklyn Generation, Brooklyn Theatre Arts, Victory Collegiate, Brooklyn Bridge Academy, Academy for Conservation and the Environment's school days based on the Office of Pupil Transportation's bus schedule for a regular school day.²¹ Where possible, the proposed schedule maintains Brooklyn Generation, Brooklyn Theatre Arts, Victory Collegiate, Brooklyn Bridge Academy, Academy for Conservation and the Environment's current allocation of time for each shared space and distributes the remaining time to Uncommon Charter High School 3. To the extent feasible, shared spaces are allocated in a manner that allows Brooklyn Generation , Brooklyn Theatre Arts, Victory Collegiate, Brooklyn Bridge Academy, Academy for Conservation and the Environment to continue using them on a similar schedule next year. Because Uncommon Charter High School 3 will be co-located in the building for the first time if the proposed co-location of Uncommon Charter High School 3 is approved, it may be necessary to shorten or change some of the times that have been allocated to Brooklyn Generation, Brooklyn Theatre Arts, Victory Collegiate, Brooklyn Bridge Academy, Academy for Conservation and the Environment this year so that all students in the building may be accommodated in 2014-2015 and subsequent school years.

In planning how Brooklyn Generation , Brooklyn Theatre Arts, Victory Collegiate, Brooklyn Bridge Academy, Academy for Conservation and the Environment and Uncommon Charter High School 3 use the shared space, the DOE has applied some or all of the factors described above to develop a proposed plan that allocates time in each space equitably.

Cafeteria

- There are two cafeterias in the building, which each have the capacity to hold 700 students.
- The total time allocated to each organization in the cafeteria is primarily based upon current use of the cafeteria by the schools currently located in building K515, the projected enrollment of each school in K515 during 2014-2015, the capacity of the cafeteria, and the grade levels served by each school. Each organization will be able to accommodate its students in the cafeteria within this proposed allocation of time.
- In the proposed plan below, Brooklyn Generation, Brooklyn Theatre Arts, Victory Collegiate, Brooklyn Bridge Academy, Academy for Conservation and the Environment are allocated lunch times that utilize both cafeterias, which each have the capacity to hold 700 students. Brooklyn Bridge Academy currently serves lunch from 10:27am – 11:10am.²² In the proposed plan, Brooklyn Bridge Academy will continue to serve lunch at this time in Cafeteria 1. Brooklyn Theatre Arts High School currently serves lunch from 10:52am – 11:05am.²³ In the proposed plan, Brooklyn Theatre Arts will continue to serve lunch at this time in Cafeteria 2. Brooklyn Theatre Arts also currently serves lunch from 11:05 am-12:26 pm. Brooklyn Theatre Arts will continue to serve lunch at this time in Cafeteria 1. Brooklyn Bridge Academy will continue to serve lunch at this time in Cafeteria 1. Victory Collegiate High School currently serves lunch from 11:15am – 12:30pm.²⁴ In the proposed plan, Victory Collegiate High School will continue to serve lunch at this time in Cafeteria 2. Brooklyn Generation currently serves lunch from 12:25pm – 11:05pm.²⁵ In the proposed plan, Brooklyn Generation will continue to serve lunch at this time in Cafeteria 1. Academy for Conservation and the Environment currently serves lunch from 11:20 am -12:04 am.²⁶ In the proposed plan, Academy for Conservation and the Environment will continue to serve lunch at this time in Cafeteria 1. Uncommon Charter High School 3 is currently not in the building and therefore is not currently serving lunch. In the proposed plan, Uncommon Charter High School will serve lunch from 12:30pm-1:15pm in Cafeteria 2.
- With regard to breakfast, the DOE notes that, traditionally, not all students have opted to participate in the breakfast program in K515. Uncommon Charter High School 3 is currently not in the building they do not currently participate in the school's breakfast program. In the proposed plan, Brooklyn Generation, Brooklyn Theatre Arts, Victory Collegiate, Brooklyn Bridge Academy and Academy for Conservation and the Environment currently use the cafeteria from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. for breakfast and will continue to serve breakfast at this time. In the proposed plan, Uncommon Charter High School 3 will serve breakfast from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.

Other Shared Spaces

Gymnasium

- There are two gymnasiums in the building, which have the capacity to hold 920 and 420 students respectively.
- The DOE proposes that the gymnasiums be allocated relative to the projected enrollments of each school.
- In the proposed schedule, Brooklyn Theatre Arts is allocated the largest amount of time in Gymnasium 1, 17.5 hours weekly, because it will serve the greatest number of students. Brooklyn Bridge Academy is allocated 12.5 hours weekly in Gymnasium 1 and Uncommon Charter High School 3 is allocated

5 hours per week in Gymnasium 1. Academy for Conservation and the Environment and Victory Collegiate High School are both allocated 10 hours weekly in Gymnasium 2 and Brooklyn Generation is allocated 7.5 hours per week in Gymnasium 2. Although Brooklyn Theatre Arts, Brooklyn Bridge Academy, Academy for Conservation and the Environment, Victory Collegiate High School, Brooklyn Generation and Uncommon Charter High School 3's times in the gymnasium overlap with their designated times in other shared spaces, the DOE notes that not all students follow the same schedule and students may transition from one area to another.

Library

- There is one library in the building.
- The DOE proposes that the library be allocated relative to the projected enrollments of each school.
- The DOE proposes that Brooklyn Theatre Arts receive the greatest amount of time in the library, .5 hours weekly, because it will serve the greatest number of students. Victory Collegiate, Brooklyn Generation and Academy for Conservation and the Environment are each allocated 4 hours and 10 minutes weekly in the library. Brooklyn Bridge Academy and Uncommon Charter High School 3 are allocated 2.5 hours weekly in the library. It is possible that the time that each school is allocated in the library overlaps with their designated times in other shared spaces. The DOE notes that not all students follow the same schedule and students may transition from one area to another.

Auditorium

- There is one auditorium in the building, which has the capacity to hold 994 students.
- The DOE proposes that the auditorium be allocated relative to the projected enrollments of each school.
- The DOE proposes that Brooklyn Theatre Arts receive the greatest amount of time in the auditorium, 7.5 hours weekly, because it will serve the greatest number of students. Victory Collegiate is allocated 6 hours in the auditorium each week. Brooklyn Generation and Academy for Conservation and the Environment are each allocated 5 hours weekly in the auditorium. Brooklyn Bridge Academy is allocated 3.5 hours per week and Uncommon Charter High School 3 is allocated 2.5 hours weekly in the auditorium. It is possible that the time that each school is allocated in the auditorium overlaps with their designated times in other shared spaces. The DOE notes that not all students follow the same schedule and students may transition from one area to another.

Music Room

- There is one music room in the building.
- The DOE proposes that the music room be allocated relative to the projected enrollments of each school.

Dance Room

- There is one Dance Room in the building. At the time of the walkthrough, the capacity of the room was not available
- The DOE proposes that the Dance Room be allocated relative to the projected enrollments of each school.

Weight Room

- There is one Weight Room in the building. At the time of the walkthrough, the capacity of the room was not available
- The DOE proposes that the Weight Room be allocated relative to the projected enrollments of each school.

Home Economics Room

- There is one Home Economics room in the building. At the time of the walkthrough, the capacity of the room was not available
- The DOE proposes that the Home Economics room be allocated relative to the projected enrollments of each school.

Science Lab

- There is one shared science lab in the building currently being shared by Brooklyn Generation and Victory Collegiate.
- The DOE proposes that this science lab remain being shared by Brooklyn Generation and Victory Collegiate.
- The walkthrough notes that each of the other co-located schools located in K515 are allocated 1 science lab each

After-School Programs

- In the schedule below, the DOE does not allocate any time in the shared spaces after the end of the school day. The Building Council will address all requests for use of the shared spaces after school hours and may allocate the shared space as needed for after-school programs.

In 2013-2014, Brooklyn Generation School is projected to serve 272 students, Brooklyn Theatre Arts High School is projected to serve 380 students, Victory Collegiate High School is projected to serve 326 students, Academy for Conservation and the Environment is projected to serve 280 students, Brooklyn Bridge Academy is projected to serve 190 students and GED Plus is projected to serve 90 students. Based on information from the Office of Pupil Transportation's bus schedules for the earliest start and latest end times of the school day, Brooklyn Generation's school day runs from approximately 8:30 a.m. to 3:20 p.m., Brooklyn Theatre Arts' school day runs approximately from 8:30 a.m. to 2:43 p.m., Victory Collegiate High School's school day runs from approximately 8:40 a.m. to 3:37 p.m., Academy for Conservation and the Environment's school day runs from approximately 8:45 a.m. to 3:15 p.m., and Brooklyn Bridge Academy's school day

runs from approximately 8:33 a.m. to 3:33 p.m.²⁷ Since Uncommon Charter High School 3 is a new schools, they do not yet have a current school start or end time.

Based on the explanations provided above, the DOE believes that the proposed Shared Space Plan below is feasible and that each school is being treated equitably and comparably in its ability to use all shared spaces in the building.

Building Safety and Security

Pursuant to Chancellor’s Regulation A-414²⁸, every school/campus must have a School Safety Committee. The committee plays an essential role in the establishment of safety procedures, the communication of expectations and responsibilities of students and staff, and the design of prevention and intervention strategies and programs specific to the needs of the school. The committee is comprised of various members of the school community, including principal(s); designee of all other programs operating within the building; United Federations of Teachers Chapter Leader; Custodial Engineer/designee; and In-house School Safety Agent Level III. The committee is responsible for addressing safety matters on an ongoing basis and making appropriate recommendations to the Principal(s) when it identifies the need for additional security measures, intervention, training, etc.

The committee is also responsible for developing a comprehensive School Safety Plan which defines the normal operations of the site and what procedures are in place in the event of an emergency. The plan must be consistent with the Citywide prescribed safety plan shell. Each program operating within a school must enter program-specific information in the School Safety Plan. Safety plans are updated annually by the School Safety Committee in order to meet changing security needs, changes in organization and building conditions and other factors. In addition, the committee recommends changes in the safety plan at any other time when it is necessary to address security concerns.

Consistent with the process described above, the leaders/designees of Uncommon Charter High School 3 will be part of the K515 School Safety Committee. As a member of the School Safety Committee, the leaders/designees of Uncommon Charter High School 3 will participate in the development of the building’s Safety Plan and ensure that any security-related issues or needs which may arise with respect to the co-location of Uncommon Charter High School 3 will be addressed on an ongoing basis. Moreover, the Safety Plan for the K515 school building will be modified as appropriate to meet any changing security needs associated with

the co-location. The leaders/designees of Uncommon Charter High School 3 will enter information in the K515 schools' overall Safety Plan to ensure the safe operation of the school building.

Each school building must also establish a Building Response Team that will consist of trained staff members from each of the schools, and which is activated when emergencies or large building-wide events occur. The members of this team must be identified and listed in the School Safety Plan.

The completed School Safety Plan for the K515 school building will be submitted to the Borough Safety Directors of the Office of School and Youth Development for approval. If changes or modifications are necessary, the School Safety Committee will be advised. Once the School's Safety Plan is approved, it will be submitted to the New York City Police Department (NYPD) for final approval and certification by the NYPD.

Proposed Communications Strategy

As per the Campus Policy Memo 2011,²⁹ co-located schools must actively participate in a Building Council (BC), which is a campus structure for administrative decision-making for issues impacting all schools in the building. Only principals and charter school leaders serve on the BC. The BC shall meet at least once a month to discuss and resolve issues related to the smooth daily operation of all the schools in the building and the safety of the students they serve. The BC principals and charter school leaders, where applicable, communicate their decisions campus-wide to staff, students and parents, especially as related to issues of safety, shared space, campus schedules, split-staff agreements and extended facility use.

A Shared Space Committee (SSC) shall be established by the principals of the schools at campuses where charter schools are co-located in a public school building with one or more non-charter schools or District 75 schools, as set forth in Chancellor's Regulation A-190. With respect to charter school co-locations approved after May 28, 2010, the effective date of the amended Charter Schools Act, the SSC is to review the implementation of the Building Utilization Plan once it has been approved by the PEP. With respect to charter schools that were approved to be located or co-located in a public school building prior to the effective date of the amended Charter Schools Act, the SSC shall review implementation of the current building space plans in place at those buildings. The SSC will meet at least four times per year.

The SSC will be comprised of the principal, a teacher and a parent of each co-located school. With respect to a non-charter school's teacher and parent members, such SSC members shall be selected by the corresponding constituent member of the School Leadership Team of the school. Charter school leaders will work with their constituencies to select the parent and teacher representing that school. SSC agendas and minutes shall be shared with the BC. SSC members may be asked to communicate with their constituencies about the BUP and its campus implementation.
