

## **Dress Code Policy**

It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that all students attend school appropriately attired.

In an attempt to clarify "appropriately attired", the P.S. 113 community has adopted the following enforceable dress code to be adhered to by all students:

- 1. Clothing must be clean, modest and age-appropriate.**
2. Clothing which contains suggestive, vulgar, violent words and/or images is expressly prohibited.
3. Clothing that is deemed to be excessively short is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, spaghetti strap tank-tops, tube-tops, short skirts, short shorts and any exceptionally tight-fitting or low-cut garments.
4. Clothing or accessories that are deemed a safety hazard are expressly prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, dangling jewelry, unnecessarily oversized apparel and unsafe footwear, such as, backless slippers or high-heeled or platform shoes.

In the event of an honest disagreement as to the acceptability of a student's attire, the principal or his designee will make the final determination as to the appropriateness of the attire.

In the event a student is found to be in violation of the dress code, the student's parents will be called to school in order to bring an appropriate change of clothing.

**No student will be permitted to attend class in violation of the dress code.**
