

2014/2015 Teacher's Choice Eligibility Requirements

New York City Department of Education employees who are actively employed as of November 1, 2014 are eligible to receive Teacher's Choice funding. Eligible titles, along with their respective funding amounts, are listed in the following table:

New York City Department of Education Title	Funding Amount
Teaching titles (includes general education teachers, special education teachers, staff developers, teacher trainers, coaches, library teachers, attendance teachers, speech teachers, adult education teachers, permanent substitute teachers ¹ , and ROTC instructors ¹)	\$77
Clinicians (guidance counselors, social workers, and school psychologists)	\$47
Laboratory specialists	\$37
High school assistant principals who teach at least one high school class per day ²	\$37
School secretaries	\$25

Notes:

- Absent Teacher Reserve (ATR) staff in the above titles who meet eligibility requirements will also receive funding.
1. Permanent substitute teachers and ROTC instructors with a '5BA', '5BP', or 'TBR' status in their EIS profile must submit a *Full-Time Substitute/ROTC Instructor Certification Form* in order to receive funds.
 2. High school assistant principals who teach at least one high school class must submit a *High School Assistant Principal Certification Form* in order to receive funds.
