### Early Childhood Education – Social Advocacy & Support

#### *What we do*

LYFE serves children ages 8 weeks – 3 years old and their student parents enrolled in NYC Department of Education schools and programs. LYFE provides free high-quality childcare services for infant and toddlers, while their student parents attend school. In addition, LYFE assists student parents with achieving their educational goals and strengthening their parenting skills by providing counseling, referrals, and advocacy.

#### *How we serve*

Certified Teachers and Caregivers at each site provide safe, nurturing and meaningful learning experiences for infant and toddlers and help student parents do the same at home. On-site Social Workers offer support services, such as individual and group counseling and referrals to social, health and community agencies.

#### *Where we serve*

LYFE has over 30 sites located throughout all 5 boroughs of NYC to meet student parents' needs.

#### *When we serve*

LYFE classrooms hours are determined by students' needs. LYFE sites are typically open from 7:30am to 3:30pm but if needed, classroom hours are extended to support student parents' school schedules.
