Bridges Transitions Inc.

***Service(s):** The Bureau of Nonpublic School Reimbursable Services is requesting to enter into a requirements contract with Bridges Transition Inc. This will allow Bridges as needed to continue programs which provide web-based courseware and professional development for high school students and teachers in nonpublic schools. Bridges also provides online access to New York Regents, SAT and PSAT courses to over 5,000 students and professional development to 73 teachers from 36 nonpublic schools.*

The term of this contract is for 3 years from September 1, 2006 through August 31, 2009, with an option to renew for one additional year. The cost for the first year is \$222,300 and the total estimated cost is \$720,900.

***Service(s):** The Bureau of Nonpublic School Reimbursable Services is requesting to enter into a requirements contract with Plato Learning. This will allow Plato as needed to continue its programs which provide web-based courseware and professional development for K-12 students and teachers in nonpublic schools. In addition, Plato Learning offers engaging and interactive instructional content and assessments for struggling and mainstream K-12 learners.*

The term of this contract is for 3 years from September 1, 2006 through August 31, 2009, with an option to renew for one additional year. The cost for the contract is an estimated annual amount of \$438,800 and the total estimated cost is \$1,316,400.

New Teacher Center

Service(s): The Office of New Teacher Induction (ONTI) is requesting an extension of an existing contract with the New Teacher Center (NTC), University of California, Santa Cruz. NTC is the professional development provider for the city-wide New Teacher Induction Program which provides mentoring to all first-year teachers in New York City.

The current NTC contract will expire on August 31, 2006 and ONTI needs two more years to fully develop the capacity of the DOE leadership team. The total cost of the additional two years is \$2.8 or \$1.4 million annually.
