ITEM(S) FOR CONSIDERATION:

1. Center for Alternative Sentencing and Employment Services (CASES)

Service(s): The Office of Alternative, Adult and Continuing Education Schools and Programs is requesting a non-competitive award for a three-year agreement with CASES. CASES will facilitate a school re-engagement program at the Community Prep High School for students returning from the custody of law enforcement. Over the last five years CASES has worked in partnership with the DOE to facilitate the transition of court-involved youth to community schools.

The term of this agreement will be for 3 years from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2009 at a total cost of \$600,000, or \$200,000 annually.

TERM: 7/1/2006-6/30/2009 Contract Cost: \$600,000
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2. Heart of Change; Change of Heart Associates

Service(s): Region 3 is requesting a non-competitive award to continue to use Heart of Change. Heart of Change has been working with Region 3 for the past 2 years, and the prior Professional Development RFP that was utilized has now expired. Heart of Change provides direct services to principals and school teams to build the capacity for school leaders and instructional supervisors and coaches.

The term of this agreement will be from July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2007 at a cost of \$137,500.
