ITEM(S) FOR CONSIDERATION:

1. Community Service Society's Experience Corps

Service(s): *The Office of Teaching and Learning is requesting a non-competitive award with Community Service Society (CSS) to continue its effective intervention program for low-performing schools in District 29, Queens. CSS brings together an intergenerational nationwide movement of senior volunteers, a network of public schools sites and a meticulous research-based approach that helps children at risk of academic failure.*

The term of this agreement is from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 for a cost of \$400,000, about 22 percent of the total cost for the non-profit CSS to run this program.

TERM: 7/1/2006-6/30/2007

Contract Cost: \$400,000

2. Madison Square Garden Facilities

Service(s): *The Public Schools Athletic League (PSAL) is requesting a non-competitive award for the use of Madison Square Garden facilities to conduct the PSAL Basketball City Championship Games which will be held one day in the month March for the calendar years of 2007, 2008 and 2009.*

The term of this agreement will be from March 2007 through March 2009 at a cost of \$127,200.

TERM: 3/2007-3/2009

Contract Cost: \$127,200

3. Reliance Communications, Inc.

Service(s): *The Office of Pupil Attendance and the Division of Instructional Technology is requesting an interim non-competitive award with Reliance Communications, Inc., for maintenance and support of the autodialer equipment for 498 New York City schools. The autodialer systems are used for verification of student attendance.*

The term of this agreement will be from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 at a cost of \$192,633, by which time a competitively awarded contract will be in place.

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4. John Jay College of Criminal Justice

Service(s): *The Regional Operating Center E is requesting an interim non-competitive award with John Jay College of Criminal Justice for the provision of vocational training classes for incarcerated students on Rikers Island Correctional Facility.*

The term of this agreement will from September 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 at total cost of \$124,688, by which time a competitively awarded contract will be in place.
