A11: Other: New York State Education Department (NYSED), as part of its implementation of the provisions of Education Law Article 3012-c requiring annual professional performance reviews of classroom teachers and principals, approved a list of 15 organizations that are eligible to provide this service. The DOE began using the Danielson evaluation methodology in 2011 and it is one of the NYSED approved rubrics. UFT endorsed this rubric and the DOE agreed to implement it citywide. At this time, the Danielson approach is only available through Teachscape.
