4. Service(s) The Office of Safety and Youth Development (OSYD) seeks to amend the value of the contract with SAGA Innovations, Inc. (SAGA) for a demonstration project to study an innovative approach to academic intervention services called high-dosage tutoring. The contract amendment will increase the original budget by \$1.15 million for school year 2015-2016 and \$1.15 million for school year 2016-2017, while allowing for expansion of the tutoring services up to 684 students; an increase of 80% over the original contract scope.
