1. United Federation of Teachers, Educational Foundation, Inc.

***Service(s): The Bureau of Nonpublic School Reimbursable Services is requesting a non-competitive award to enter into a contract with the United Federation of Teachers, Educational Foundation, Inc., (UFT) on the behalf of the Teacher Center to provide graduate courses for nonpublic school teachers and administrators. The UFT Teacher Center, in collaboration with area colleges and universities, offers a wide variety of graduate courses for New York City educators. These courses are held at UFT Borough Offices in all five boroughs.***

***The Bureau's existing contract with UFT expires on August 31, 2007. The term of the proposed replacement contract would be five years from September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2012 at a cost of \$3,750,000, or \$750,000 annually.***
