The Department of Education's (DOE) Chancellor's Committee on Contracts (COC) has been asked for approval to enter into contract negotiations with the following organization(s) for the services described below. ITEM(S) FOR CONSIDERATION:

1. School Link Technologies

Service(s): The Office of School Support Services is seeking to extend Contract #9700114 with School Link Technologies (SLT) to continue maintenance of existing Point of Service (POS) Technology, which records student participation in the breakfast/lunch program and determines eligibility for free, reduced price and full price meals.

The extension includes maintenance for 318 school cafeterias, related customer service hardware support (which is being transferred to DOE employees) and the cost of licenses for 19 additional sites.

Term: 9/1/09-8/31/10

Total Contract Cost: \$830,191

2. Amazon Web Services

Service(s): The Division of Instructional & Information Technology (DIIT) is seeking to enter into an agreement with Amazon Web Services (Amazon) to pilot the build out of technology infrastructure services, which will enable the DOE to access and utilize computing and storage services via the internet.

The pilot is intended to enable the Department to develop a business and support model for managing a "cloud" environment. Applications planned for implementation during the pilot include Learning Management Systems, collaboration tools and file sharing among schools.

Term: 5/1/10-4/30/2012

Total Contract Cost: \$321,792
