### ITEM(S) FOR CONSIDERATION:

#### 1. Cisco Systems, Inc.

***Service(s):*** *The Office of Talent and New Initiatives seeks approval to enter into a one-year pilot project with Cisco Systems, Inc. (Cisco). Cisco will provide a learning platform and tools necessary to administer an online learning experience by providing a portal for students and teachers to access content, an integrated learning management system for course delivery, video management and storage capabilities, audio/video conferencing, professional services and the integration of existing school networks and infrastructures.*

Term: 4/1/10 – 8/30/11

Total Contract Cost: \$200,000

#### 2. The Wellness Company

***Service(s):*** *The Office of Occupational Safety and Health seeks a five month extension with The Wellness Company (WC) to provide blood-borne pathogen inoculation services and post exposure counseling to employees as mandated by law.*

*WC has agreed to continue providing services under the same terms, conditions and pricing as in the expiring contract.*

Term: 4/1/10 – 8/31/10

Estimated Contract Cost: \$218,656

#### 3. Pre-Kindergarten/Early Intervention Transportation Services

***Service(s):*** *The Office of Pupil Transportation is seeking approval to extend the current requirement agreements with various vendors to provide Pre-Kindergarten/Early Intervention Transportation Services to NYC school children. The proposed contract extensions will be for 1 year with all terms and conditions remaining the same as in the expiring contracts.*
