EXPANDED PROGRAM
FOR CURRENT 10TH and 11TH GRADERS

The **Expanded** program provides current 10th and 11th graders at Renewal High Schools with learning experiences beyond traditional classrooms. Students work as apprentices to learn to teach and mentor younger students in areas such as the arts and video production, helping to prepare participants for the working world. Participants have the opportunity to exit the program with academic credit, a working portfolio, and the chance to participate in paid internships with the apprenticeship provider during the following year. This summer's apprenticeships focus on city agriculture, new media arts, visual arts, climate and culture, and creative engineering.
