

## **Manhattan District Attorney's Office First Annual Kids Against Violence Poster Contest**

### **Guidelines:**

- **Manhattan K-5 students are eligible to** participate in the Manhattan District Attorney's Office's first-annual "Kids Against Violence" poster contest.
- The submission deadline is June 12, 2012. The awards ceremony is scheduled for June 21, 2012.
- To enter, students must submit a poster on 8.5 x 11 paper along with a registration form that will be provided to their school's principal's office.
- Acceptable media includes: pencil, ink, paint, crayon, chalk, and pastel. Three-dimensional entries will not be accepted. Nothing may be glued, stapled or attached to the artwork. (Note: Chalk, charcoal and pastel entries should be sealed with a fixative spray).
- Posters may display the words "Kids Against Violence" or a unique theme created by the student.
- Only one entry per student per year is permitted, and each entry must be the work of only one student.
- Artwork that contains excessively graphic or violent images will be disqualified.
- All artwork must be the student's original creation. Duplications are not accepted.
- Posters will be judged on originality, clarity of message, and overall artistic quality.
- All posters must be submitted to Magda Dekki at 333 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue by the deadline stated above.
