### Resolution #91 Creation of Zone for Q315

Whereas, the Office of District Planning, the Community Superintendent, and the Office of Student Enrollment propose zoning changes for the current elementary schools zones of P.S. 307, P.S. 16, P.S. 19, and P.S. 13 in order to:

Create a zone for an elementary school in new building Q315, located at 96-18 43rd Avenue, slated to open for the 2015-2016 school year and to reduce the zone sizes of P.S. 307, P.S. 16, P.S. 19, and P.S. 13, and to reduce to the need to overflow students from these schools to other schools outside of the neighborhood.

The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new zone for building Q315:

- Begin at the corner of Lamont Avenue and Hampton Street, then
- Northeast on Lamont Avenue, then
- Southeast on Elbertson Street, then
- North on 94th Street, then
- East on 42nd Avenue, then
- North on 97th Place, then
- East on 41st Avenue, then
- South on 99th Street, then
  
- East on 42nd Avenue, then
- South on National Street, then
- Southeast on Nicolls Avenue, then
- South on 102nd Street, then
- East on Corona Avenue, then
- South on 104th Street, then
- West on Alstyn Avenue, then

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- Continue west on Alstyn Avenue, excluding the addresses on Alstyn Avenue between 99th Street and the alley before 98th Place, then
- Continue west on Alstyn Avenue, then
- Southwest on Corona Avenue, then
- Continue west on Corona Avenue, then
- Northwest on 91st Street, then
- West on 43rd Avenue, then
- North on Hampton Street to Lamont Avenue (point of origin)

**b.** The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 307 zone:

- Begin at the corner of 42nd Avenue and 99th Street, then
- North on 99th Street, then
- East on 38th Avenue, then
- North on 100th Street, then
- East on 35th Avenue, then
- South on 104th Street, then
- West on 37th Avenue, then
- South on 102nd Street, then
- East on 39th Avenue, then
- South on 103rd Street, then
- Continue southwest on National Street, then
- West on 42nd Avenue to 99th Street (point of origin)

**c.** The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 16 zone:

- Begin at the corner of 108th Street and 45th Avenue, then
- North on 108th Street, then
- West on 38th Avenue, then
- North on 104th Street, then
- West on 37th Avenue, then
- South on 102nd Street, then
- East on 39th Avenue, then
- South on 103rd Street, then
- Continue southwest on National Street, then
- Southeast on Nicolls Avenue, then
- South on 102nd Street, then
- East on Corona Avenue, then
- North on 104th Street, then
- East on 45th Avenue to 108th Street (point of origin)

**d.** The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 19 zone:

- Begin at the corner of 99th Street and 41st Avenue, then
- North on 99th Street, then
- East on 38th Avenue, then

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- North on 100th Street, then
- West on 35th Avenue, then
- South on 98th Street, then
- West on 37th Avenue, then
- South on 91st Street, then
- Continue southwest on Elmhurst Avenue, then
- East on Gleane Street, then
- Northeast on Whitney Avenue, then
- East on Forley Street (including both sides of Forley Street), then
- North on Lamont Avenue, then
- Southeast on Elbertson Street, then
- North on 94th Street, then
- East on 42nd Avenue, then
- North on 97th Place, then
- East on 41st Avenue to 99th Street (point of origin)

**e.** The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 13 zone:

- Begin at the corner of Corona Avenue and 90th Street, then
- Northeast on Corona Avenue, then
- Continue east on Corona Avenue, then
- Continue northeast on Corona Avenue, then
- East on Alstyne Avenue, then
- South on the alley between 98th Place and 99th Street, then
- West on 50th Avenue, then
- South on 98th Street, then
- West on 55th Avenue, then
- South on 97th Place, then
- East on 57th Avenue, then
- South through Lefrak City, then
- West along the Long Island Expressway, then
- Northwest along Queens Boulevard, then
- North on 90th Street to Corona Avenue (point of origin)

Whereas, the proposed changes would impact only incoming kindergarten students or students that are new to the system in 2015-2016; all currently enrolled students may remain in their school. Children whose verified siblings are enrolled in a school impacted by a re-zoning plan adopted by the CEC will maintain zoned sibling priority to that impacted school students will be enrolled in New York City elementary schools by the following priority:

- 1.** Zoned students whose verified siblings are pre-registered or enrolled at the time of application submission and will be enrolled in grades K-5 in the school at the start of the following school year
- 2.** Zoned students other than those in (1) above applying to the zoned school

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**3.** Students whose verified siblings are pre-registered or enrolled at the time of application submission and will be enrolled in grades K-5 in the school at the start of the following school year who are not zoned to the school,

- a. Within District first, then
- b. Out of District

**4.** Students currently attending the school's pre-kindergarten program who reside outside the school's zone, *without* a sibling who will be in grades K-5 at the school in the following school year,

- a. Within District first, then
- b. Out of District

**5.** Students other than those in (3a) and (4a) above who are residents of that district

**6.** Students other than those in (3b) and (4b) who are residents of another district

Be it resolved that the CEC District 24 agrees with and fully supports the proposed zoning lines for Q315 and the reduction of the zone lines of P.S. 307, P.S. 16, P.S. 19, and P.S. 13/

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
