Life is Precious™ is our four year old pioneering initiative that provides culturally and linguistically appropriate educational support, creative art therapy and wellness activities to Latina adolescent, who have either serious considered or attempted suicide and their families. The program's goal is to eliminate suicide ideation and attempts by Latina adolescents by giving them and their families tools that build their resilience and coping methods and provide the skills to succeed in and graduate from high school.
