**Creating a zone for X314
Located at 4520 Matilda Ave,
Bronx, NY 10466
Opening September 2015**

Whereas, CEC 11 has set the goal of creating a zone for building X314;

Whereas, District 11 is considered an “Overcrowded district”:

Whereas, PS 16 is severely overcrowded;

Whereas, a new school will open in September 2015, located at 4520 Matilda Ave, Bronx, NY 10466, to elevate overcrowding in PS 16;

Whereas, the Community Education Council District 11 is in support of rezoning to alleviate the overcrowding of PS 16;

Be resolved, that on Tuesday, November 18, 2014, the Community Education Council District 11 supports of the proposed zoning changes as follows:

1.
 - a. The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new zone for building X314:
 - Begin at the corner of White Plains Road and East 237th Street, then
 - West on East 237th Street, then
 - North on Matilda Avenue, then
 - East on East 240th Street, then
 - North on White Plains Road, then
 - East along the Bronx-Westchester County Boundary, then
 - South on Barnes Avenue, then
 - West on East 241st Street, then
 - South along the NYCTA Rail Yard, then
 - West along the NYCTA Rail Yard, then
 - South on White Plains Road to East 237th Street (point of origin).
 - b. The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 16 zone:
 - Begin at the corner of Matilda Avenue and East 237th Street, then
 - West on East 237th Street, then

“One Team Working Together”

- North on Metro North New Haven Line, then
- West on Nereid Avenue, then
- North along the Metro North Harlem line, then
- Continue north along the Bronx River Shoreline, then
- East along the Bronx-Westchester County Boundary, then
- South on Baldwin Street, then
- East along the Bronx-Westchester County Boundary, then
- North on Robertson Street, then
- East along the Bronx-Westchester Boundary, then
- South on White Plains Road, then
- West on East 240th Street, then
- South on Matilda Avenue to East 237th Street (point of origin).

2. Be further resolved: The proposed changes would impact only incoming pre-kindergarten or kindergarten students, or students that are new to the system in 2015-2016. All currently enrolled students may remain in their school. Children whose verified siblings are enrolled in a school impacted by a rezoning plan adopted by the CEC will maintain zoned sibling priority to that impacted school. Students will be admitted to kindergarten based upon the following priorities:

1. Zoned students whose verified siblings are pre-registered or enrolled at the time of application submission and will be enrolled in grades K-5 in the school at the start of the following school year
2. Zoned students other than those in (1) above applying to the zoned school
3. Students whose verified siblings are pre-registered or enrolled at the time of application submission and will be enrolled in grades K-5 in the school at the start of the following school year who are not zoned to the school,
 - a. Within District first, then
 - b. Out of District
4. Students currently attending the school's pre-kindergarten program who reside outside the school's zone, *without* a sibling who will be in grades K-5 at the school in the following school year,
 - a. Within District first, then
 - b. Out of District
5. Students other than those in (3a) and (4a) above who are residents of that district
6. Students other than those in (3b) and (4b) who are residents of another district
7. 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 2.4 add considerations for Pre-kindergarten seats
