RESOLUTION:

WHEREAS, currently middle school students in District 23 attend their zoned school, continuing K-8 school, or one of a limited number of choice options;

WHEREAS, the goals of unzoning District 23 middle schools is to increase access to educational options across the district, provide families with additional information about school options, and align admissions processes with enrollment trends.

WHEREAS, unzoning would allow the New York City Department of Education (DOE) to fully implement the Middle School Choice admissions policies;

WHEREAS, on October 25, 2012, the superintendent/DOE submitted a proposal to the Community Education Council District 23 (CEC District 23) to unzone the middle schools in District 23

WHEREAS, CEC District 23 has the legal authority to approve changes to zoning lines pursuant to Education Law §2590-e, consistent with Chancellor's Regulation A-185,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that in accordance with Education Law §2590-e, CEC District 23 approves the change in zoning lines resulting from the unzoning of District 23's middle schools effective for the 2014-2015 school year as set forth in the proposal dated October 25, 2012; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that CEC District 23 formally requests that the DOE implements a uniform District 23 Middle School Choice process beginning in the 2014-2015 academic year.

WHEREAS, currently children in District 23 are zoned to either an elementary or K-8 school;

WHEREAS, the goals of unzoning District 23 elementary schools is to increase access to educational options across the district, provide families with additional information about school options, and align admissions processes with enrollment trends;

WHEREAS, District 23 is a geographically small district, where families have multiple elementary schools located within walking distance to their places of residence;

WHEREAS, on October 25, 2012, the superintendent/DOE submitted a proposal to the Community Education Council District 23 (CEC District 23) to unzone the elementary schools in District 23;

WHEREAS, CEC District 23 has the legal authority to approve changes to zoning lines pursuant to Education Law §2590-e, consistent with Chancellor's Regulation A-185; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that in accordance with Education Law §2590-e, CEC District 23 approves the change in zoning lines resulting from the un zoning of District 23's elementary schools effective for the 2013-2014 school year as set forth in the proposal dated October 25, 2012
