A Call for Student Photography

WHO: All current New York City public school students (grades Pre-K – 12) are eligible to participate.

WHAT: A citywide architectural photography competition. Students are invited to submit architectural photographs of their schools for a citywide competition and exhibit. There will be 18 winners. In each borough, three students (one in elementary school, one in middle, and one in high school) will win. There will also be one citywide grand prize winner from each grade level.

The winning photographs will be featured in an exhibition at the Center for Architecture and in a slide show on the Department of Education Web site.
