**AMENDMENTS TO CHANCELLOR’S REGULATION C-30—REGULATION
GOVERNING THE SELECTION, ASSIGNMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF
PRINCIPALS AND ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS**

I. Description of the subject and purpose of the proposed item under consideration.

Chancellor’s Regulation C-30 governs the selection, assignment and appointment of principals and assistant principals. This revised notice is being posted to correct a typographical error in section XI.B.7 of the proposed amended regulation. The amendments described in the original notice dated April 3, 2015 remain the same. They are:

- This regulation is effective for supervisory selection processes commenced after June 30, 2015. Section I
- The Office of Supervisory Support Services promulgates guidance regarding the prior pedagogic experience requirements for principals and assistant principals. Section VII(D)(3)
- Borough Field Offices will maintain records of membership on the Level I Committee for the schools and programs they support. Section XI(B)(1)
- Supervisory representation on Level I Committees for community district positions is either a supervisor from the school at which the vacancy exists or from another school in the district, but if none is available, a supervisor from a school in the borough. Section XI(C)(1)
- Supervisory representation on Level I Committees for non-community school district positions is either a supervisor from the school at which the vacancy exists or from another school in the borough. Section XI(E)(1)
- On Level I Committees, the designee of the Cluster is replaced by a designee of the Superintendent. Sections XI(C)(1), XI(E)(1), and XI(G)(3)(b)
- Any member of a C-30 committee who breaches confidentiality may be removed from the process and barred from future service on C-30 committees. Section XVII(B)
- Principals who were appointed or assigned as interim acting principals prior to February 1, 2008 are eligible for automatic inclusion in the Principal Candidate Pool if they received satisfactory annual ratings and meet the minimum eligibility requirements for principals established by the State Education Department. Section VIII
- Language added to clarify that rejections for cause apply only to appointments made by Community Superintendents. Section XI(A)(1)(a)
- Internal inconsistency corrected to clarify that rejection for cause for Community Superintendent Principal and Assistant Principal appointments is handled by the Senior Deputy Chancellor or his/her designee on behalf of the Chancellor. Section XI(A)(1)(a)
- The Office of Leadership or the Division of Human Resources may notify Pool members of specific opportunities in their areas of expertise.
