Topic: Proposed Amendments to Chancellor's Regulation C-30

Date of Panel Vote: May 20, 2015

Summary of Proposed Amendments to Chancellor's Regulation C-30

Chancellor's Regulation C-30 governs the selection, assignment and appointment of principals and assistant principals. The following amendments are proposed:

- This regulation is effective for supervisory selection processes commenced after June 30, 2015.
- The Office of Supervisory Support Services promulgates guidance regarding the prior pedagogic experience requirements for principals and assistant principals.
- Borough Field Offices will maintain records of membership on the Level I Committee for the schools and programs they support.
- Supervisory representation on Level I Committees for community district positions is either a supervisor from the school at which the vacancy exists or from another school in the district, but if none is available, a supervisor from a school in the borough.
- Supervisory representation on Level I Committees for non-community school district positions is either a supervisor from the school at which the vacancy exists or a supervisor from another school in the borough.
- On Level I Committees, the designee of the Cluster is replaced by a designee of the Superintendent.
- Any member of a C-30 committee who breaches confidentiality may be removed from the process and barred from future service on C-30 committees.
- Principals who were appointed or assigned as interim acting principals prior to February 1, 2008 are eligible for automatic inclusion in the Principal Candidate Pool if they received satisfactory annual ratings and meet the minimum eligibility requirements for principals established by the State Education Department.

- Language added to clarify that rejections for cause apply only to appointments made by Community Superintendents.
- Internal inconsistency corrected to clarify that rejection for cause for Community Superintendent Principal and Assistant Principal appointments is handled by the Senior Deputy Chancellor or his/her designee on behalf of the Chancellor.
- The Office of Leadership or the Division of Human Resources may notify Pool members of specific opportunities in their areas of expertise.

Summaries of Issues Raised in Written and Oral Comments and Significant Alternatives Suggested

Analysis of Issues Raised, Significant Alternatives Proposed, and Changes Made to the Proposal
