KEY SCHOOL SURVEY INFORMATION

- The School Survey helps educators and the public understand what key members of the school community say about the learning environment at the school.
- Teachers, parents, and students in grades 6-12 participate every year.
- The survey is the source of community input in the school accountability process.
- Parents' and Students' responses are totally confidential. Teachers' responses are both confidential and anonymous.

SURVEY ARRIVALS

- Parent surveys will arrive at schools before citywide parent-teacher conferences in February and March.
- Student surveys and postcards for taking the online survey will arrive in schools during the week of March 4.
- Teacher postcards for taking the online survey will arrive in schools during the week of March 18.
- All surveys must be completed by April 12.

- Consider adding a message about the School Survey in email and newsletter communications that you or your organization is sending in February, March and April.
