WRITING WORKSHOP PROGRAM FOR CURRENT 9TH, 10TH, and 11TH GRADERS

The **Writing Workshop** program for current 9th, 10th, and 11th graders at Renewal High Schools strengthens student's writing skills while providing the opportunity to earn elective ELA credits. In the investigative journalism unit, students will research and profile prominent Americans and write biographical articles. In the personal essay unit, students study several formats including blogs, traditional narratives, and humorous essays. The unit will culminate with students producing a short personal essay that can be used during the college application process.
