Dear 10th Grade Parents/Guardians:

As you know, **Thursday evening is our "4th Annual Curriculum Overview/Meet the Teacher Night and Book Fair."** This is an opportunity for you to receive a brief overview of your child's curriculum and classroom policies from your child's core subject teachers.
