### Expectations and Qualifications:

- The Scholars' Academy offers rigorous and accelerated coursework. Students are expected to maintain an 85 and above average, adhere to a discipline and dress policy, and complete three high school level courses by the end of grade 8.
- Continuing students in Scholars' Academy HS will be on pace for earning Regents and Advanced Regents Diplomas by the end of tenth grade enabling the completion of advanced placement and college accredited courses in 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades.
- Interested students must demonstrate a history of strong academic achievement supported by minimum standardized test scores in grade 4 of 669 on the January 2008 NY State ELA Exam and 684 on the March 2008 NY State Mathematics Exam.

Driving Directions: Beach Channel Drive to Seaside Avenue (B103 Street), turn south toward elevated train line, park vehicle on Beach Channel Dr., Seaside Avenue, or Beach 104 Street. Bus Directions: Q22, Q21, or Q53 to Beach 102<sup>nd</sup> Street and Rockaway Beach Blvd. Walk north along B 102 St. toward the elevated train (Rockaway Freeway); continue on Rockaway Freeway, under elevated train, one block west to Seaside Avenue (B103 St.)
