The Achievement and Reporting Innovation System, (ARIS) provides valuable academic information to school administrators, teachers, students and their families. Through ARIS Parent Link, parents/guardians may have access to the same information as their children's teachers so that they may become a more active partner in their child's education.

We are excited about extending ARIS Parent Link training across the District to achieve a goal of over 50% parent usage by June 2011. To support our schools in reaching this ambitious goal, District 27 will be offering monthly trainings for parents at various locations. Additionally, we encourage all schools to continue to facilitate regular ARIS Parent Link training to build upon the good work that has already begun.

Kindly note that any parent wishing to attend one of the workshops below, **MUST** pre-register at their own school. Classes are limited to no more than 25 participants; therefore, acceptance to the session will be based on a first come basis. Five (5) days prior to each training session, we ask that schools forward the names of parents wishing to attend, along with their temporary password and their child's OSIS number to each *school's facilitator*.
