ROADS Charter School I, an existing charter school located at 1495 Herkimer Street Brooklyn, New York 11233 in Community School District (“CSD”) 23, which will serve approximately 200 students in grades 9-11 during the 2014-15 school year and ROADS Charter School II, located at 1010 Rev. James A. Polite Ave., Bronx, NY 10459 in CSD 12, which will serve approximately 200 students in grades 9-10 during 2014-15 school year; propose to enter into separate management agreements with ROADS Schools Inc., a New York not-for-profit, charter management organization, to manage their educational programs. The schools also propose to defer enrollment growth for the third year of their charters only (2014-15 SY) from 250 students to 200 students in the same grade configuration to focus on the current cohorts to allow proficiency and credit attainment.
