Student Uniform Policy

Please be advised that The Science and Medicine Middle School 366 (SMMS) is a uniform school. At all times students are required to wear the official school uniform as follows:

All students:

- Students are required to wear their white lab coats at all times while in school. Lab coats are to be kept clean and neat.

For our young men:

- Male students are required to wear khaki colored pants and a light blue shirt.
- During colder weather only, a dark blue sweater is acceptable.
- The lab coat is worn at all times.

For our young women:

- Female students are required to wear khaki colored skirts or slacks and a light blue shirt.
- During colder weather only, a dark blue sweater is acceptable.
- The lab coat is worn at all times.

Physical Education (PE) Class:

- On days when the students are scheduled for Physical Education (PE), students are permitted to wear plain navy blue sweat pants and sweat shirts. The sweat suits are not to have any writing, stripes, or designs.
- Students must wear sneakers during PE class.
- There are no scheduled PE classes on Friday. All students are required to wear their regular uniforms on Friday.

The following items are not permitted at SMMS 366 at any time:

- Head coverings – including hats, hoods, bandannas, or similar items.
- Short pants of any type.
- Sleeveless shirts of any type.
- Hooded sweat shirts or sweaters.
- Open toed shoes, including flip flops.

Field Trips:

- Students must wear the official school uniform – including white lab coat – while on a field trip.
