At its meeting on Wednesday, May 7, 1980, the Board of Education adopted the following Brief Calendar for the School Year 1980-1981. This calendar is subject to change pursuant to upcoming collective bargaining.

- September 3, Wednesday.....All Classroom Teachers, Bilingual Teachers in school and Community Relations, Guidance Counselors, Laboratory Specialists and Technicians, and Secretaries report.
- September 5, Friday.....Attendance Teachers, Psychologists and Social Workers report.
- September 8, Monday.....SCHOOL SESSIONS BEGIN FOR ALL STUDENTS.
- September 11, Thursday and
September 12, Friday.....Rosh Hashanah (Schools Closed).
- October 13, Monday.....Columbus Day (Schools Closed).
- November 4, Tuesday.....Election Day (Schools Closed).
- November 11, Tuesday.....Veteran's Day (Schools Closed).
- November 27, Thursday and
November 28, Friday.....Thanksgiving Recess (Schools Closed).
- December 24, Wednesday through
January 2, Friday.....Christmas Recess (Schools Closed).

1981

- January 19, Monday.....Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (Schools Closed).
- January 30, Friday.....Fall Term Ends.
- February 2, Monday.....Spring Term Begins.
- February 13, Friday.....Lincoln's Birthday (Schools Closed).
- February 16, Monday.....Washington's Birthday (Schools Closed).
- April 17, Friday through
April 24, Friday.....Spring Recess (Schools Closed).
- May 25, Monday.....Memorial Day (Schools Closed).
- June 4, Thursday.....Anniversary Day (BKlyn. & Queens Schools Closed).
- June 26, Friday.....Last day of school session for all Classroom Teachers, Laboratory Specialists and Technicians, and last day for Paraprofessional service.

- June 29, Monday and
June 30, Tuesday.....All other staff report except Classroom Teachers, Laboratory Specialists and Technicians, and Paraprofessionals.

This school year provides a total of 185 instructional days on all school levels in the Bronx, Manhattan and Staten Island, and 184 days in Brooklyn and Queens.

Any district which, in violation of this officially adopted city-wide brief calendar, closes a school or schools other than for those special emergency situations provided for under Board of Education procedures and practices, shall be assessed an amount equivalent to reductions in State Aid caused by such closing. This will prevent other community school districts from bearing the burden of reduced State Aid resulting from such actions.
