
SAT Participation for Juniors in NYC

In March 2016, New York City piloted an SAT administration during the school day for juniors in 91 schools. It drove a substantial increase in participation.

The number and percent of juniors who took the SAT at least once in three years of high school



2015-16 SAT Reporting Updates

For prior releases of SAT results for seniors, the NYC DOE used the aggregate results provided by the College Board. This year, we have created the aggregate results using student-level datasets that are then matched to DOE records. This is a better approach because the data links back to our own demographic and cohort information, better aligns to data reported on the School Quality Reports, and allows us to develop more nuanced analyses.

Because of this new method, participation and performance numbers may differ from those provided before. For example, last year, we reported 48,678 students took the SAT by their senior year in 2015. However, this year we report 45,533 for 2015.













SAT Scores by Subject for Seniors for NYC, the Nation and the Rest of New York State (ROS)


