

RESOLUTION REGARDING THE AGGREGATION OF THE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGETS, AS MODIFIED AND APPROVED BY THE CHANCELLOR, TOGETHER WITH A PROPOSED BUDGET FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BOARD AND THE CHANCELLOR

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2590-r of the New York State Education Law, the Panel for Educational Policy (the “Panel”), must approve an aggregation of the community school district budgets, as modified and approved by the chancellor, together with a proposed budget for the administrative expenditures of the city board and the chancellor (the “Aggregated Budget”); and

WHEREAS, the Aggregated Budget represents the conclusion of the school-based budgeting process required by Section 2590-r of the New York State Education Law and Chancellor’s Regulation B-801; and

WHEREAS, it is the Panel’s desire to prevent any delay in the completion of the school-based budgeting process, which would necessarily have a deleterious effect on the operation of schools and the health, safety, and general welfare of students and the school system as a whole; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2590-g(9) of the New York State Education Law, the Panel has the authority to adopt the Aggregated Budget on an interim basis for 60 days, or until the Panel votes to permanently approve the Aggregated Budget following a 45-day public notice and comment period, whichever comes first; and

WHEREAS, the Chancellor recommends that the Panel approve the Aggregated Budget set forth in Appendix A attached hereto; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that in accordance with Sections 2590-g(9) and 2590-r of the Education Law, the Panel hereby approves the Aggregated Budget on an interim basis for 60 days, or until the Panel votes to permanently approve the Aggregated Budget following a 45-day public notice and comment period, whichever comes first.
