

## The Big Apple Awards: *Recognizing Teacher Excellence in New York City* 2013 Frequently Asked Questions

### The Big Apple Awards Nominations

#### Q. Who can nominate a teacher?

A. Anyone – supervisors, colleagues, parents, students, staff, and community members – can submit a nomination for a current New York City Department of Education (NYCDOE) teacher by **March 13, 2013**.

#### Q. What information is required for a nomination?

A. Please include:

- 1) Nominated teacher's name
- 2) Nominated teacher's school name and borough

#### Q. What kind of teachers should I nominate?

A. Current, full-time NYCDOE teachers who have demonstrated exceptional success in the following areas: (I) Impact on Students' Learning, (II) Instructional Practices, and (III) Professional Contributions.

#### Q. Can I nominate myself?

A. Yes, self-nominations will be accepted.

#### Q. Am I able to nominate more than one teacher?

A. Yes, you may nominate more than one teacher for this award.

#### Q. Should I submit more than one nomination for any one individual?

A. No, you should not submit more than one nomination for the same individual.

#### Q. Who will see my nomination information?

A. The Big Apple Awards team and review committee will have access to nomination information. It is possible that statements from nominations will be used anonymously for the promotion of the award program.

### Award Selection Process

#### Q. What happens after a teacher is nominated?

A. All nominees will be notified via email about the honor of being nominated for the first annual Big Apple Awards. After a review of nominations, a select group of nominees will be invited to complete a more comprehensive application by early April.

**Q. If I am invited to apply, what happens after I complete my application?**

A. All complete applications will be reviewed and Big Apple Awards Finalists will be named. Finalists will be interviewed and visited in their classrooms. Up to 11 awardees will be announced and honored at a celebration in June.

**Q. What does it mean to be a Big Apple Award winner?**

A. The awardees will spend the 2013-2014 school year, in addition to teaching, serving as ambassadors and advisors for the Department of Education.
