Bridging the Gap Between Our Schools and the Workplace

Eligibility

- Students must be registered with an approved NYCDOE high school or GED program before intake, or;
- Have earned a high school diploma, IEP diploma or GED
- Be 16– 20 years old

High School students may earn up to 4 vocational credits per semester (up to 8 total credits towards HS diploma).
