Summary of Proposed Amendments to Chancellor’s Regulation D-140

Chancellor's Regulation D-140, Process for the Nomination and Selection of Members of the Community Education Councils Including Filling Vacancies, sets forth the procedures of the NYC Department of Education (“DOE”) for the nomination and selection of Community Education Council (“CEC”) members. The following amendments have been proposed:

- In accordance with recent amendments to the New York State Education Law, the definition of the term “ELL parent” has been expanded to include the parent of a child who is either currently an English language learner or who has been an English language learner within the preceding two years.

Summary of Issues Raised in Written and Oral Comments and Significant Alternatives Suggested
