1. This school year provides a total of 185 instructional days on all school levels in the Bronx, Manhattan and Staten Island, and 184 days in Brooklyn and Queens.
2. Any district which, in violation of this officially adopted city-wide brief calendar, closes a school or schools other than for those special emergency situations provided for under Board of Education procedures and practices, shall be assessed an amount equivalent to reductions in State Aid caused by such closing. This will prevent other community school districts from bearing the burden of reduced State Aid resulting from such actions.
