1. Two letters of reference commenting on character and ability. *Letters cannot be from family.*
2. A Legible & Original Essay “*Why the Association of Electrical Contractors, Inc. should award an A.E.C. Scholarship to you*”. (The essay should be between 300 and 400 words).
3. A Copy of your High School Transcript.
4. A Copy of your Parents’ or Legal Guardian’s most recent Tax Return.
