Requirements

An Edmodo Certified Trainer possess or complete the below steps:

- Strong understanding of the Edmodo platform and it's integration into school, district, and/or classroom practice.
- Completion of a train-the-trainer course
 - Attend a face-to-face kickoff event
 - Date: July 23rd | Time: 9:00 - 12:00 or 1:30 - 4:30
 - Location: 425 W. 123rd Street (6th floor) | [Google Map](#)
 - Participate in 3 weekly live webinars (recorded and shared for those who cannot attend live.)
 - The remaining coursework is delivered through an Edmodo group. This includes review of content, hands-on practice, reflection, and collaborative discussion with fellow participants. Approximate time for completion is 15 hrs.
 - Attend a face-to-face celebration
 - August 20th

Upon completion of all requirements, you will receive:

- Edmodo Store credit to install and integrate Edmodo Apps
- The ECT digital badge which can be shared in places such as your website, blog, email signature
- Letter of completion which explains, in detail, the work you have completed as a participant in the train the trainer course for the ECT program
- Certificate
- An official Edmodo Certified Trainer shirt
- Membership in the ECT Professional Learning Community (PLC) group

- Connect directly to the Edmodo Team and a global network of your peers

Expectations

Status as an Edmodo Certified Trainer must be renewed each year by following the below steps

- Host 2 or more face to face trainings for 10 or more educators each year
- Complete a summary of work form at the end of the year
- Receive satisfactory review on the [Edmodo Training Evaluation form](#) which is shared at the end of each training with all participants
 - Results report directly to Edmodo and will be shared with you for review.
 - This will be used to provide an annual summary of your training activities
- Be an active participant in the ECT PLC, responding to the Edmodo Team, sharing best practices, success stories, challenges, and resources with your peers
- Remain sharp in your “Edmodo expertise” by:
 - Reviewing posts in the ECT PLC group
 - Following the Edmodo blog, Twitter, and What’s New Help Center page
 - Attending or viewing recordings of product update and program webinars
- “Rep” Edmodo with professionalism in Edmodo groups, communities, and face to face opportunities
