**Teaching Firms of America-Professional Prep Charter School is in its first charter term [2010-2015]. For academic year 2014-15 there is a projected enrollment of 272 students served in grades K-4. The school's projected full grade span is K-5 which it is projected to reach in 2015-16 upon renewal and approval. This is the fourth year of operation.**

The mission of Teaching Firms of America—Professional Preparatory Charter School, is to prepare students to become the future professionals (lawyers, doctors, scientists, entrepreneurs, etc.) who will lead our global society in the 21st Century.
