Un vistazo a las escuelas secundarias está diseñado para ayudarlo a identificar rápidamente las escuelas secundarias a las que su hijo le gustaría ingresar. Lo que sigue es una tabla completa, organizada por municipio, enumerando cada escuela secundaria y sus cinco características más importantes:

- 1) **Nombre del programa** – Todos los programas que ofrecen las escuelas tienen un nombre diferente, que debe incluir en su solicitud de ingreso a la escuela secundaria.
- 2) **Código del programa** – Cada programa tiene un código diferente de 4 dígitos que también debe incluir en su solicitud de ingreso a la escuela secundaria.
- 3) **Área de interés** – Cada programa tiene un área de interés específica seleccionado de la lista que figura a continuación. En esta publicación cada área de interés se asigna en una columna vertical por separado, lo que permitirá que usted identifique de inmediato los programas que comparten un área de interés en particular. - 4) **Método de selección** – Cada programa tendrá su propio método de selección (enumerado en la columna del área de interés del programa). Los métodos de selección se describen a continuación:

A Audición – Programas que exigen que usted demuestre dominio de un área específica de las artes interpretativas y escénicas. Los requisitos de la audición, fechas y horas de los programas específicos están listados en el Directorio de escuelas secundarias.

E Opción educativa (Ed. Opt.) – El cincuenta por ciento (50%) de los estudiantes es clasificado para los programas por el personal de la escuela y el otro cincuenta por ciento (50%) es seleccionado al azar por un computador. Ambos grupos son escogidos de acuerdo con la siguiente distribución de los puntajes en lectura de los exámenes estandarizados del año anterior:

- 16% del rango de lectura alto*
- 68% del rango de lectura promedio
- 16% del rango de lectura bajo

* Los estudiantes que en este examen obtienen un puntaje que los clasifica dentro del **2% máximo** e incluyen en primer lugar un programa de opción educativa en su solicitud tienen garantizada una asignación a ese programa.

L Parcialmente no selectivo – Programas que seleccionan estudiantes al azar por medio de una computadora. Se les da prioridad a los estudiantes que, conjuntamente con sus padres, demuestren interés en una escuela asistiendo a la sesión informativa o a las jornadas de puertas abiertas del establecimiento educativo.

S Selectivo – Programas en los cuales el personal de la escuela clasifica a los estudiantes de acuerdo al expediente académico final del año anterior, a los puntajes en los exámenes estandarizados, la asistencia a clases y la puntualidad. Le recomendamos que revise los criterios de elección para cada programa selectivo (enumerados en el Directorio de escuelas secundarias) para que determine si desea presentar la solicitud.

T Examen – Programas que requieren que el estudiante deba rendir el examen de ingreso a las escuelas secundarias especializadas (SHSAT, por sus siglas en inglés).

U No selectivo – Programas para los que los estudiantes son seleccionados al azar por medio de una computadora.

Z Zonal – Programas que les dan prioridad a los estudiantes que viven en el área zonal geográfica de la escuela secundaria.

8 Estudiantes continuos de 8.º grado – Programas abiertos sólo para los estudiantes de 8.º grado que desean continuar en la escuela secundaria y están inscritos actualmente en una escuela con grados tanto de intermedia como de secundaria.

5) Página del Directorio – Cada escuela tiene su propia página en el *Directorio de escuelas secundarias públicas de la Ciudad de Nueva York 2008-2009*. Para obtener mayor información acerca de los programas enumerados en esta publicación, incluyendo las síntesis detalladas de sus cursos, las actividades extracurriculares y los equipos de deportes de la liga PSAL, consulte la página de esa escuela en el Directorio.

Además de la información provista en el Directorio, si usted está interesado en obtener más información sobre el desempeño de una escuela, visite la página web del Departamento de Educación en www.nyc.gov/schools e ingrese el nombre de la escuela. Cuando aparezca la lista de escuelas, haga clic en la escuela que le interesa. Cuando aparezca la página de esa escuela, haga clic en “*Statistics*” (Estadísticas) de la columna del lado izquierdo. Esto le dará acceso a una gran cantidad de datos estadísticos de la escuela, incluyendo el informe de la encuesta sobre el entorno de aprendizaje, el informe de la revisión de calidad, el informe de progreso y el informe anual de la escuela.

TEMAS A CONSIDERAR CUANDO ASISTA A LAS FERIAS Y A LAS JORNADAS DE PUERTAS ABIERTAS

⇒ Venga preparado

- Mantenga varias charlas con su hijo acerca de sus intereses, cuestiones sobre el transporte, etc.
- Use su directorio de escuelas secundarias para identificar la escuela que le interesa a su hijo. Utilice pequeñas notas tipo *Post-it* para marcar las páginas de las escuelas que le interesa visitar en la feria. En cada página con una marca *Post-It*, resalte aquella información que necesite que le aclaren o que le expliquen con más detalle. Escriba cualquier pregunta que pueda tener en la página de la escuela o en la nota *Post-It*. Asegúrese de:
 - Encontrar programas que estén de acuerdo con los intereses de su hijo
 - Revisar las primeras páginas del directorio en caso de que necesite aclaraciones en las definiciones de “método de selección” y “requisitos”
 - Familiarizarse con los requisitos de las escuelas que le interesan
 - Familiarizarse con el método de selección que figura en cada **programa** que le interesa
 - Consultar los mapas del directorio para identificar las escuelas que están cerca de su casa. Si le interesan las escuelas que están más alejadas de su casa, asegúrese de revisar donde queda cada una de estas escuelas y el viaje que debe hacer para llegar hasta ellas. Utilice la página web www.hopstop.com con el propósito de determinar el tiempo de viaje y el transporte público que necesita para llegar a la escuela. Recuerde contemplar todos los métodos posibles de transporte público para que su hijo llegue a la escuela a tiempo. Asegúrese de que su hijo pueda aguantar diariamente el viaje que tendría que hacer a la escuela
- Una vez que haya identificado las escuelas que les interesan a usted y a su hijo, continúe indagando acerca de las mismas. Por ejemplo, en la página de inicio del Departamento de Educación: www.nyc.gov/schools, ingrese el nombre de una escuela. Una vez que aparezca la página de Internet de la escuela, haga un clic en “Statistics” en la columna ubicada a la izquierda. Este enlace le dará acceso a muchas de las estadísticas de la escuela, incluyendo las siguientes:
 - Informe de la encuesta sobre el entorno de aprendizaje
 - Informe sobre la revisión de calidad
 - Informe de progreso
 - Informe anual de la escuela
- Revise toda la información que ha recopilado y escriba cualquier otra pregunta que pueda tener.

⇒ Haga una lista de preguntas y prepárese para recopilar nueva información

No haga preguntas cuyas respuestas figuran en la información impresa en el directorio. Usted debería ver en la feria de escuelas secundarias una oportunidad para ahondar y entender más sobre las escuelas que ha identificado en el directorio como aquellas a las que a su hijo le interesa ingresar.

- Haga preguntas sobre las dudas que hayan surgido como resultado de lo que ha investigado en el directorio de escuelas secundarias.
- Pregunte acerca de la cultura de la escuela: ¿Cómo es la escuela? ¿Cómo interactúan los estudiantes entre sí y con los maestros, etc.?
- Haga preguntas acerca de un programa típico para los alumnos que ingresan a 9.º grado: ¿A qué hora empieza la jornada escolar y a qué hora termina? ¿A qué hora terminan los estudiantes generalmente sus actividades extracurriculares?
- ¿De qué manera la escuela maneja el aprendizaje acelerado y el refuerzo académico?
- Pregunte sobre los servicios de intervención.
- Una vez que haya leído las estadísticas, pida que le aclaren aquella información sobre la que tenga dudas.
- Haga preguntas sobre el área que le interesa a su hijo. ¿Cómo se integra el tema de la escuela con el programa de estudios y con determinadas clases? ¿Hay clases específicas que se relacionan con el interés de su hijo?
- Pregunte sobre oportunidades específicas para que los estudiantes de 9.º grado tomen las clases que figuran en el directorio.
- Pregunte acerca del tamaño promedio de la clase en una escuela en particular.
- Recopile información durante las jornadas de puertas abiertas y visitas guiadas a las escuelas. Escriba todas las fechas de jornadas de puertas abiertas y visitas guiadas.
- Averigüe cuándo son los eventos especiales (por ejemplo las reuniones de la Asociación de padres y maestros, eventos deportivos, conciertos, espectáculos, etc.) que se llevan a cabo este otoño en una escuela en particular y trate de asistir a esos eventos.
- Averigüe el nombre y el correo electrónico o el número de teléfono de la persona que está a cargo de las jornadas de puertas abiertas, las visitas guiadas y las otras actividades relacionadas con el ingreso a la escuela. Si la escuela no tiene fechas de jornadas de puertas abiertas, quizás le interese preguntar si no hay algún modo de realizar una visita junto con su hijo.
- Si el directorio de escuelas dice que es obligatorio que los estudiantes usen uniforme, pregunte de qué tipo de uniforme se trata y si incluye algún costo.
- A continuación algunas otras preguntas que pueden ser importantes:
 - ¿Qué tipo de temas son algunos de los que le preocupan a los estudiantes en su escuela?

- ¿En qué actividades están involucrados los padres en la escuela?
- ¿Cuántos estudiantes se gradúan cada año?
- ¿Cómo se comunica la escuela con los padres sobre (a) lo que ocurre en la escuela y (b) sobre el progreso académico de su hijo?

⇒ Traiga un cuaderno

Además de escribir directamente en la página de una escuela en particular en el directorio de escuelas secundarias, quizás usted quiera recopilar información en un cuaderno.

⇒ Planifique su visita

Llegue tan pronto como pueda al comienzo de la Feria e inmediatamente consulte la guía de la Feria de escuelas secundarias que le será entregada una vez que entre al edificio. Si hay talleres programados a lo largo del día, usted deberá decidir a qué talleres asistirá antes de comenzar a visitar las exhibiciones de las escuelas. Si no planifica de forma apropiada, se perderá los talleres. Si no se da a usted mismo el tiempo suficiente para recorrer la Feria a un paso tranquilo, el día se le volverá estresante. Tómese unos minutos para consultar la distribución del piso en el que está y evalúe a donde le gustaría ir basándose en las escuelas que previamente ha identificado en su Directorio de escuelas secundarias. El personal de la Oficina de Planificación y Administración de Inscripción Estudiantil estará disponible durante el día para asistirlo. Planificar bien le permitirá hacer de este evento algo productivo e informativo.

⇒ Visite específicamente las mesas de las escuelas que le interesen

Una vez que haya marcado el Directorio de escuelas secundarias, haya hecho preguntas y haya planificado su visita, está listo para comenzar a ver las mesas de exhibición de las escuelas que le interesan.

- Antes de recoger panfletos de una mesa de exhibición, averigüe si hay alguien al que le pueda hacer las preguntas que tenga. Generalmente hay maestros, personal de orientación, padres y estudiantes trabajando en cada mesa de exhibición. A menudo el director de la escuela se encuentra en la exhibición.
- Si hay muchos padres en una mesa en particular, no se dé por vencido. Tome un folleto y mírelo mientras está esperando. Manténgase en su lugar hasta que pueda hacer sus preguntas.
- No olvide obtener el nombre, el cargo y el número de teléfono de una persona de contacto en la escuela para hacer más preguntas y averiguar sobre las fechas de las sesiones informativas y las visitas guiadas.
- Asegúrese de **firmar** en cada mesa que visite.

- Recoja de la mesa solamente aquellos objetos que piense que enriquecerán lo que usted sabe de la escuela. No es necesario que se lleve a su casa pilas de papeles y panfletos.

Después de visitar una mesa tómese un momento para charlar con su hijo sobre la escuela y sus programas. ¿Hay algo más que su hijo quiera saber? Estimule a su hijo a decir lo que piensa durante las reuniones en la mesa de exhibición con los funcionarios de la escuela.

Después de terminar la visita a las escuelas que había identificado, observe el Directorio una vez más para determinar si hay otras escuelas que le gustaría visitar. De ser así, pase la última hora visitando esas mesas.

⇒ Tome notas

Después de visitar muchas mesas, usted puede necesitar acordarse de las respuestas que le han dado las escuelas específicas que le interesan. Por consiguiente, es bueno tomar notas. Anote palabras o frases clave.

⇒ Otras recomendaciones

- Vístase con ropa liviana y viaje sin mucho equipaje.
- Use calzado cómodo
- Deje su automóvil en casa. Utilizar el transporte público es el modo más fácil para llegar a la Feria

⇒ Antes de irse de la feria

Asegúrese de haber visitado todas las escuelas que había diagramado en su Directorio de escuelas secundarias. Si tiene alguna pregunta acerca del proceso de ingreso a la escuela secundaria, pregúntele al personal de la Oficina de Planificación y Administración de Inscripción Estudiantil.

⇒ Una vez que llegue a su casa

Dentro de las 48 horas de haber visitado una feria haga lo siguiente:

- Doble la punta de las páginas (o arranque las páginas del directorio) de las escuelas que visitó.
- Retire las páginas del cuaderno con las anotaciones de las preguntas que hizo.
- Engrampe la(s) página(s) del cuaderno con la página correspondiente a cada escuela.
- Vacíe la bolsa de los materiales que juntó y distribúyalos por escuela. Abroche esos materiales con las páginas correspondientes del directorio de escuelas secundarias.
- Revise las escuelas junto a su hijo.
 - ¿Qué fue lo que averiguó sobre las escuelas que le interesaban?

- ¿Qué inquietudes surgieron?
- ¿Qué preguntas adicionales tiene? (usted deberá llamar directamente a la escuela)
- Decida si le gustaría ir a la sesión informativa para saber más acerca de una escuela en particular. En caso negativo, ¿dejaría de considerar a esa escuela como una posibilidad?
- Si acudió a la exhibición de alguna escuela que no había investigado previamente, tómese el tiempo de buscar información sobre esa escuela ahora. Siga los consejos sobre cómo estar preparado que le detallamos en este documento.
- Haga un calendario y ubíquelo en un lugar que esté siempre visible y que pueda revisar a menudo.
 - Incluya las fechas de las sesiones informativas y las visitas guiadas de todas las escuelas que le interesen.
 - Incluya las fechas de las audiciones de todas las escuelas que le interesen.
 - Incluya las fechas del examen de ingreso a las escuelas secundarias especializadas si quiere que su hijo tome el examen. **Asegúrese de inscribirse con el consejero vocacional en la escuela intermedia de su hijo.** (En el Manual del estudiante para escuelas secundarias especializadas puede encontrar las instrucciones sobre cómo inscribirse).
 - Averigüe si la escuela intermedia de su hijo organizará su propia feria o si tendrá una noche informativa sobre escuelas secundarias y ponga esa fecha en su calendario.
 - Incluya la fecha del taller sobre el ingreso a la escuela secundaria al que desea ir. Estos talleres brindan información detallada sobre el proceso de ingreso a la escuela secundaria. Las fechas se publicarán en las guías de ferias municipales y de la ciudad, distribuidas en ferias y en la Internet en: www.nyc.gov/schools/ChoicesEnrollment/High/Calendar
 - Incluya las fechas de las ferias municipales. Decida a que ferias municipales asistirá en base a la información que haya adquirido en la Feria de la ciudad.

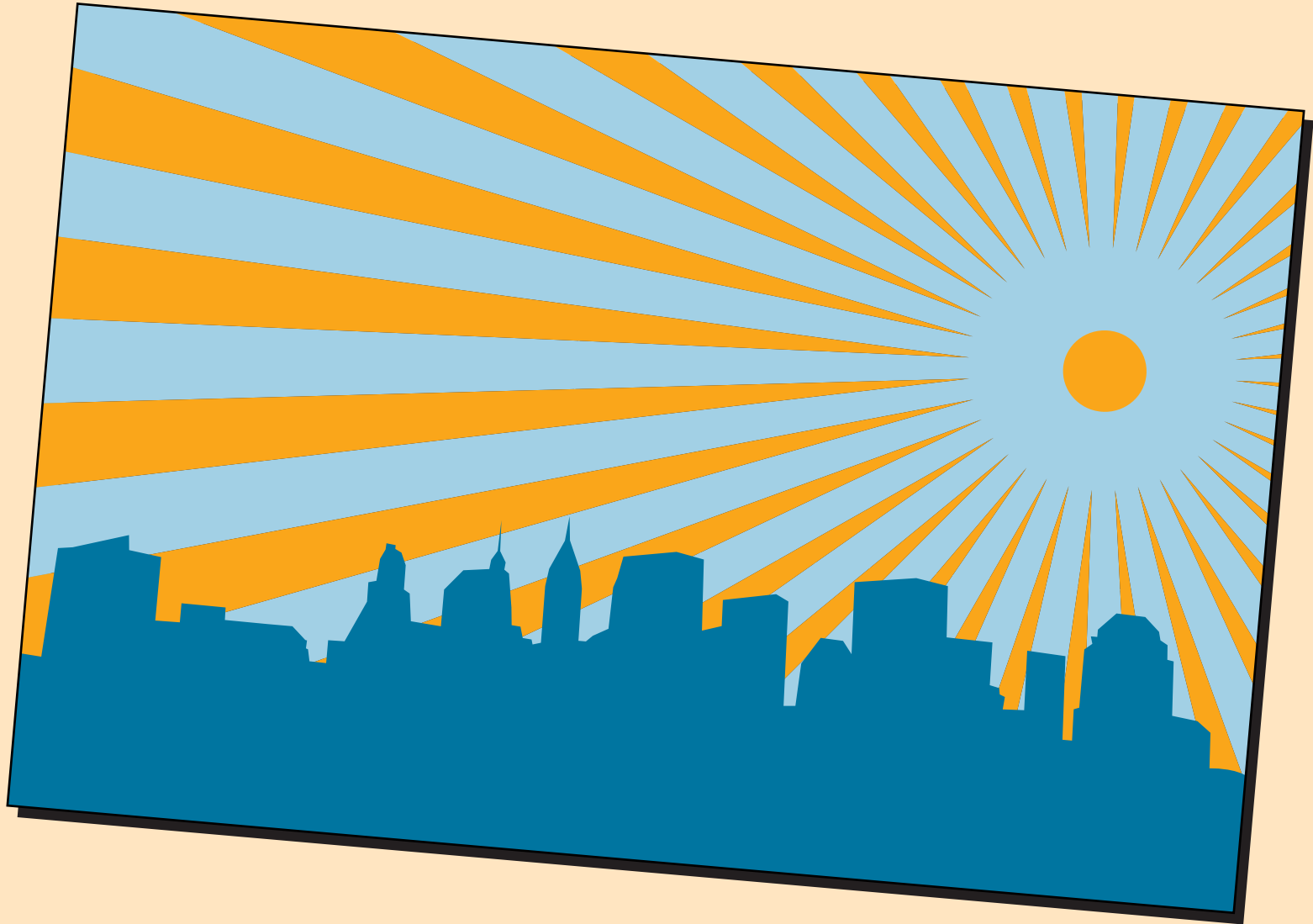
