



Cell Phone Policy

As per Chancellor's Regulation A-413, students are permitted to bring the following electronic items to school: (1) cell phones; (2) laptops, tablets, iPads and other similar computing devices; and (3) portable music and entertainment systems, such as iPods, MP3 players, PSP and Nintendo DS.

As of March 2015, PS 536 will implement the following policies about cell phones and other electronic devices:

- Cell phones and other devices **may not be used inside the school.**
- Students must keep devices turned off and stored in backpacks.
- Students who violate the school's policy, Chancellor's Regulations, or the DOE's Internet Acceptable Use and Safety Policy, will be subject to discipline in accordance with the guidance interventions and disciplinary responses set forth in the Discipline Code, including confiscation of the electronic device.
- If a student's device is broken, misplaced or lost, PS 536 is not responsible for replacement.

This policy is consistent among all schools in the PS 102 Educational Campus.
