Educational Impact Statement

I. Description of the subject and purpose of the proposed item under consideration.

In the 2010-2011 school year, 31R071, a new elementary school serving grades PreK-5, will be housed in school building R831 (hereinafter referred to as “R831”) located at 211 Daniel Low Terrace, Staten Island, NY in Community School District 31 (“District 31”). R831 has a capacity of 386, and its 2008-2009 utilization rate was 79%.

P.S. 16 and 31R071 will share an elementary school zone. With the phase-in of the new elementary school, 31R071, the enrollment of P.S. 16 will decrease and the school will ultimately be able to serve all of its students in its main building. When 31R071 is at scale, it will be the sole school in the R831 building, and P.S. 16 will be housed entirely in its main building. This proposal creates an additional elementary school option for families living in this zone.
