Educational Impact Statement

I. Description of the subject and purpose of the proposed item under consideration.

Beginning in 2010-2011, 17K748, a new elementary school will implement a gradual phase in of grades K-5 in school building K398 (hereinafter referred to as “K398”) located at 60 East 94th Street, Brooklyn in Community School District 17 (“District 17”). 17K748 will co-locate with P.S. 398 Walter Weaver (17K398, “P.S. 398”) in K398. K398 has a capacity of 1,000, and its 2008-2009 target utilization rate was 34%.

Beginning in 2010-2011, 17K748 will serve grades K-1 with an enrollment of 100-120 students. An additional grade will be added each school year until the school reaches its full grade scale in 2014-2015. At scale, 17K748 will have an enrollment of 340-360 students.

P.S. 398 Walter Weaver (17K398, “P.S. 398”) is currently housed in K398 and will remain in the building. K398 has sufficient space for P.S. 398 and 17K348 to operate at full organizational capacity. This proposal addresses the need to provide additional elementary school seats in District 17.
