3. Demonstrated ability in understanding and executing the scientific method.
4. Demonstrated ability and experience in working effectively with scientific material.
5. Teachers with three or more years of **satisfactory** teaching experience and ratings.
6. Demonstrated effective classroom management and organization skills.
7. Demonstrated creative and innovative approaches to instruction.
8. Demonstrated ability and experience in understanding and implementing methods and techniques in individualization of instruction.
9. Demonstrated willingness to work collaboratively with classroom teachers.
10. Flexible work schedule.
11. Good record of attendance and punctuality.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Work with small and large groups (N-6) of children providing science instruction aligned to state and city initiatives.
2. Preparing Grade 4 students for the State Science Exam.
3. Working with classroom teachers in order to provide instructional support, as well as duties and additional assignments that are consistent with the position and/or needs of the center.
4. Conduct Staff Development and support for science clusters.
5. Visit schools to conduct a pre-visit orientation, focus lessons, follow-up lessons, etc.
6. Responsible for ordering and organizing science materials.
7. Conduct interactive activities which correlate to NYS Core Curricula, implement inquiry-based science investigations utilizing various organisms, and provide professional development for teachers and parents to implement Family Science at school sites.
