

Resolution Regarding Approval of the Proposed Revision of the Building Utilization Plan for the Co-Location of Uncommon Charter High School 2 with Brooklyn Academy High School (13K553), Bedford Stuyvesant Preparatory High School (13K575), and a District 75 School (75K373@79K575), in School Building K458

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Law § 2853(3)(a-3)(4) the Panel for Educational Policy (“Panel”) has the power to approve revisions to Building Utilization Plans describing the allocation of space in school buildings in which one or more public charter schools are co-located with one or more district schools; and

WHEREAS, on November 25, 2013, the Department of Education posted a proposed revised Building Utilization Plan for the co-location of public charter school Uncommon Charter High School 2 with district schools Brooklyn Academy High School (13K553), Bedford Stuyvesant Preparatory High School (13K575), and a District 75 school, 75K373@79K575 in building K458 (the “Proposed Revised BUP”); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law §§ 2590-b(1)(c), notice and a brief description of the Proposed Revised BUP was circulated to all community superintendents, community district education councils, community boards, and school based management teams at least ten business days in advance of the Panel meeting at which the Proposed Revised BUP came before the Panel for a vote; and

WHEREAS, the Chancellor recommends that the Panel for Educational Policy approve the Proposed Revised BUP; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Panel for Educational Policy to approve the Proposed Revised BUP; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that in accordance with Education Law § 2853(3)(a-3)(4), the Panel for Educational Policy hereby approves the proposed revision of the Building Utilization Plan for the co-location of public charter school Uncommon Charter High School 2 with district schools Brooklyn Academy High School (13K553), Bedford Stuyvesant Preparatory High School (13K575), and District 75 school 75K373@79K575 in building K458.
