RESOLUTION #93

ZONING P.S.329

Whereas, the NYC Department of Education has secured the St. Gabriel's School, now known as P.S. 329Q located at 26-25 97th Street, East Elmhurst; and

Whereas, the obtaining of P.S. 329Q necessitates the carving of a zone from which to draw students; and

Whereas, the DOE submitted a draft proposal creating a zone for P.S. 329;

Whereas, Community District Education Council 30 (subsequently referred to as "CDEC30") has reached out to the impacted by means of meetings, electronic and social media; and

Whereas, CDEC30 has worked collaboratively with the DOE in an effort to accommodate the needs of the involved school communities; and

Whereas, CDEC30 believes that the plan now submitted by Dr. Philip A. Composto, District 30 Community Superintendent represents the best available compromise between all parties; and

Whereas, CDEC30, in collaboration with the DOE, will monitor the implementation of this plan and its impact upon the community.

Therefore Be It Resolved that CDEC30 accepts and approves the following zoning plan for P.S. 329 as submitted by Community Superintendent Dr. Composto:

1. Goal(s) of the proposal: The Office of Portfolio Management, the Community Superintendent, and the Office of Student Enrollment propose zoning changes for the current elementary school zones of P.S. 127, P.S. 148, P.S. 149, P.S. 228, and New School to be located in new building Q329 in order to:

- a. Create a zone for New School
- b. To reduce the zone size of P.S. 127

2. Schools affected by the proposal: New School, P.S. 127, P.S. 148, P.S. 149, and P.S. 228

3. Effective date for initial implementation: This plan is being implemented for September 2013, inclusive of the 2013-2014 admissions process.

A complete description of all zone line changes:

a. The addresses contained in the following area would be in the New School's elementary school zone:

- Begin at southeast corner of Astoria Boulevard and 88th Street, then
- East on Astoria Boulevard, then
- South on 106th Street, then
- West 32nd Avenue, then
- South on 102nd Street, then
- West on Northern Boulevard, then
- North on 98th Street, then
- West on 30th Avenue, then
- North on 88th Street to Astoria Boulevard (the point of origin)

b. The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 127 elementary school zone:

- Begin at the southeast corner of Grand Central Parkway and 82nd Street, then
- East on Grand Central Parkway, then

- East on La Guardia Access Road, then
- East on Flushing Bay Shoreline, then
- West on Astoria Boulevard, then
- North on 82nd Street to Grand Central Parkway (the point of origin).

c. The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 149 and P.S. 228 shared elementary school zone:

- Begin at the southeast corner of 30th Avenue and 91st Street, then
- East on 30th Avenue, then
- South on 98th Street, then
- West on Northern Boulevard, then
- South on 94th Street, then
- West on 34th Avenue and inclusive of both sides of the street, then
- South on 93rd Street, then
- West on 35th Avenue, then
- South on 90th Street, then
- West on 37th Avenue, then
- North on 87th Street, then
- West on 35th Avenue, then
- North on 83rd Street, then
- East on Northern Boulevard, then
- North on 91st Street to 30th Avenue (the point of origin).


d. The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 148 elementary school zone:

- Begin at the southeast corner of Astoria Boulevard and 82nd Street, then
- East on Astoria Boulevard, then
- South on 88th Street, then
- East on 30th Avenue, then
- South on 91st Street, then
- West on Northern Boulevard, then
- North on 79th Street, then
- East on 31st Avenue, then
- North on 83rd Street, then
- West on 25th Avenue, then
- North on 82nd Street to Astoria Boulevard (the point of origin).

3. A statement of how students will be admitted to the affected schools: The proposed changes would impact only incoming kindergarten or students that are new to the system. All currently enrolled students may remain in their school. As stated in chancellor's regulation A-101, Kindergarten students would be admitted in the following order of priority:

- *First Priority.* Zoned students with verified siblings who will be enrolled in grades 1-5 in the school as of September 2013.
- *Second Priority.* Zoned students without siblings applying to the zoned school
- *Third Priority.* Non-zoned students with verified siblings who will be enrolled in grades 1-5 in the school as of September 2013:
 - a. Within district first, then
 - b. Out of district
- *Fourth Priority.* Non-zoned students without siblings:
 - a. Within district first, then
 - b. Out of district

*During the year of implementation, current in-zone siblings who would be zoned out based on the proposed line will be grandfathered as an in-zone sibling.
