

Dear Parent/Guardian,

As a result of the federal *No Child Left Behind Act*, your child may be eligible for after school help in the areas of math, reading, and English Language Arts. Your child is eligible to receive this free tutoring, called Supplemental Educational Services (SES), if he or she attends a Title I school that is “in need of improvement,” and if he or she is eligible for free or reduced price lunch.

More than 70 state-approved SES organizations are contracted with the Department of Education to offer free programs after school and on weekends in schools, community centers, neighborhood locations and homes, as well as through the Internet.

This parent guide explains how SES works and what you, as a parent or guardian, should do to access these free services. The guide contains a directory of state-approved SES providers, an SES enrollment form, a calendar of important dates and instructions on selecting a provider and completing the enrollment form. In addition, your child’s school has information about the providers offering services in the school building. Of course, you may choose a program offered at other non-school locations too. Just remember that your child can only be enrolled in one SES program per school year.

When deciding which tutoring program is best for your child, please consider your child’s specific learning needs. You may want to consult with your child’s teacher or school for help in making the choice.

Lastly, your school may hold a provider fair so you can talk directly to the providers and decide which program is best for your child. # **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT SES**

## **What are Supplemental Educational Services (SES)?**

Supplemental Educational Services are tutoring programs offering extra help in reading, English Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics provided free-of-charge to eligible students in certain public schools. These services are provided outside of the regular school day in schools, in program provider centers, at libraries and community centers, online or at a student's home.

## **Who can get these services?**

Students who are eligible for free or reduced price lunch AND are enrolled in certain Title I schools that have been placed on the state's "in need of improvement" list are eligible to receive free SES tutoring.

## **What is a "Title I School in Need of Improvement?"**

Title I schools that fail to show adequate yearly progress in the same subject and grade are considered in need of improvement. For grades 3 through 8, schools are identified based on students' progress on New York State English language arts and mathematics tests. High schools are identified based on student progress in English language arts and/or mathematics regents and graduation rates.

## **Are all eligible students guaranteed SES Services?**

We currently anticipate that all eligible students will be able to receive SES services however, in accordance with federal law, if there are not enough funds to provide services to all eligible students who wish to participate, enrollment will be prioritized based on academic need. This means that the eligible students with the greatest educational needs will be accommodated first.

## **How will I know if my child is eligible?**

Your child's school will notify you if your child is eligible for SES tutoring. If you think your child may be eligible, but you have not received any information, check with the school's Parent Coordinator or Principal.

## **How do I find an SES Program for my child?**

This Parent Guide includes a directory of SES providers that describes their state-approved tutoring programs and provides contact information for each of them. You may speak with any of these SES providers or you may ask your child's school to help you choose the best provider for your child, but the choice is ultimately yours.

## **What happens after I've chosen an SES provider?**

After your child's enrollment form is processed, the SES provider you selected will contact you and arrange a start date, time and location for the program you've selected. (Each provider may have a different start date, but if you have not heard from the provider by the official start date, contact them or your child's school.) You may also meet with the

provider to develop your child's Student Education Plan (SEP), which will indicate specific goals for your child, establish the schedule for services, and explain how your child's progress will be measured. The NYC Department of Education (DOE) will pay for the SES program. If you have questions, do not hesitate to contact the Parent Coordinator or Guidance Counselor at your child's school.

You should ensure that your child regularly attends the SES program you have selected in order for him/her to receive the maximum benefit from this tutoring. If you remove your child from an SES eligible school, your child will no longer be eligible to receive SES. Please be sure to inform the provider you have selected of such a situation. If you re-enroll your child in an SES eligible school, you must notify your child's new school of your desire to re-enroll your child in his/her SES program. Re-enrollment in an eligible school and in an SES program must occur prior to your child returning to SES tutoring.

### **What happens if I choose an at home provider?**

#### **Parents/Guardians need to:**

- Determine a schedule for the home visits, such as the day of the week and time for each visit.
- Contact the selected provider to schedule tutoring sessions.
- Request the name and contact information of the tutor who will be assigned to your child.
- Ensure that an adult is present at all times during the tutoring sessions.
- Ask for proper identification, such as a photo identification badge, when the tutor first visits.
- Ensure they sign an SES attendance sheet for each service time provided after the tutoring session, not before the session ends.
- Know they can refuse to sign an attendance sheet for any date when services were not provided or where the time is incorrect.
- Know they should not sign attendance sheets if tutoring did not take place in the home or at a location where the parent/guardian is not present.
- Contact the provider or SES Program Office if they encounter problems with the tutor or find the schedule for tutoring sessions to be inconvenient for the family.
- Ensure that siblings receiving services from the same provider and/or tutor are not tutored at the same time.

### **How will I know how my child is doing?**

The provider MUST prepare, at minimum, a quarterly report listing your child's attendance, his/her academic progress, and the goals for the next quarter. The provider MUST give you a copy of each report and must send another copy to your child's school. If you don't receive these progress reports, please ask the provider for your copies or contact your child's school for assistance.

### **Will the City provide transportation to SES programs?**

No. School districts are not required to provide or pay for transportation. Therefore, you should select a provider conveniently located to your child's school or your home.

### **What if I am not satisfied with the provider I have selected for my child?**

Contact the provider and your child's school about any problems or concerns you have with the SES services and try to work out the issues. The NYC DOE SES Program Office

can also work with you to ensure that the provider you have selected for your child is responsive to your concerns.

**Where can I get more information?**

To learn more about SES in your area, you may:

You are encouraged to attend the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) orientation session at your child’s school. This orientation will describe eligibility requirements and the selection process. Your child’s school may also hold a provider fair where you can learn more about the SES programs available for your child.

**HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE**

1. Review the provider information. Services may vary – please speak with the provider for the final contracted information as to hours, dates and times of service.
2. Identify several providers that seem to best meet the needs of your child. (The Demonstrated Effectiveness and Qualifications information was taken from the New York State Education Department (NYSED) website and the providers themselves.)
3. Plan to attend the school’s provider fair.
4. Contact the providers and ask them for more information about their programs.
5. Speak with your child’s Parent Coordinator or Guidance Counselor if you have any questions.
6. Select only **one** provider, **one** service type and **one** corresponding service code.
7. Complete and sign the SES enrollment form.
8. Return the completed enrollment form to the school’s Parent Coordinator or the provider you have selected.

## **THE SES SELECTION PROCESS** **A Step-by-Step Guide**

1. SES information is sent home to parents/guardians of SES eligible students.
2. Parents/guardians review the information provided, attend school meetings and provider fairs and access additional information on the available SES providers from their child's school, web sites and/or the providers directly.
3. Parents/guardians select an SES provider.
4. Parents/guardians fill out the SES enrollment form – entering the name and ID number for the selected provider as well as the selected service type and its corresponding service code.
5. Parents/guardians sign and date the enrollment form.
6. Parents/guardians return the enrollment form to the school's Parent Coordinator or send the enrollment form to the selected provider.
7. The provider signs and dates the enrollment form and sends it to the SES Program Office for processing.
8. The SES Program Office processes the enrollment form, entering the information in to the DOE's NCLB database.
9. The provider "accepts" the student and contacts the parent to arrange for services to begin.
10. SES services begin. A Student Education Plan is completed.
11. Quarterly progress reports are completed by the provider. Copies are sent to the child's school as well as parents/guardians.

### **WHY YOUR CHILD'S FORM MAY NOT BE PROCESSED**

1. The enrollment form is not signed and dated by a parent/guardian.
2. The parent/guardian signature was forged, crossed out or changed in some other manner. (The enrollment form is a legal document and only original signatures are accepted.)
3. The SES provider did not sign the enrollment form.
4. The name of the SES provider selected by the parent/guardian does not match the provider ID number indicated on the enrollment form.
5. The parent/guardian did not indicate an SES service code.
6. A school label with your child's information was not affixed to the enrollment form.
7. The wrong school label was affixed to the enrollment form.
8. Your child's OSIS number and/or full name was not on the school label affixed to the enrollment form.
9. Your child is not eligible for SES services.
10. Another enrollment form was already received. (Only one, original enrollment form per student per school year will be accepted.)
11. The SES provider selected is not approved to serve students in your child's grade or to provide the service type selected.
12. The enrollment form sent to the SES Program Office is a photocopy. (Only legal, original enrollment forms will be accepted.)
13. The enrollment form was received by the SES Program Office after the enrollment deadline.

## INSTRUCTIONS

**STEP 1:** Review the provider information and speak with a representative or your child's school to find the best SES program for your child.

**STEP 2:** Fill out the SES enrollment form.

1. Fill out your current contact information.
2. Read the consent statement.
3. Print the provider's name and unique provider ID number in the appropriate sections of the enrollment form in the boxes provided.
4. Print the type of service selected and the corresponding service code for that type of service in the boxes provided.
5. Sign and date the enrollment form.

**STEP 3:** Return the completed SES enrollment form to the school's Parent Coordinator or your selected SES provider so they can submit it for processing.

**Please make sure that signed enrollment forms are given to your child's school or selected SES provider as soon as possible. We require that providers submit applications to the SES Program Office as quickly as possible to ensure your child receives services in a timely manner.**

**STEP 4:** Call or email your selected provider if you haven't heard from them regarding the start date, time and location of their program for your child.

**STEP 5:** On the first day of tutoring, your child will be given a pre-test to identify the areas in need of improvement. In addition, the provider may ask you to share information such as report cards and IEPs in order to assist them in developing your child's Student Education Plan (SEP). The SEP will outline the goals, objectives and timeline by which your child's progress will be measured. The provider will ask you to sign the SEP. Please be sure to ask for a copy for your records. Your child's SEP should be complete within the first few weeks of your child's SES program start date.

### PARENT/GUARDIAN CHECKLIST

- ✓ All SES providers must be approved by the New York State Education Department and must have a contract with the New York City Department of Education before they can offer services to eligible New York City public schools and eligible students.
- ✓ There is NO fee associated with SES tutoring by an approved SES provider. Your child's school and the SES Program Office can assist you in selecting the provider based on your child's needs.
- ✓ When you review the SES providers listed in this guide, please be aware that those programs with an asterisk (\*) may not have completed their contracting process by the time SES is scheduled to begin and that final services may vary from what is listed in this guide.
- ✓ The DOE cannot predict with 100% certainty which providers will have contracts ready by the time SES services start in the fall. Please ask the provider if they have a current contract or call the SES Program Office at (718)935-2424 if you need assistance.
- ✓ Review this Parent Guide and contact the providers you feel would best serve the needs of your child.
- ✓ Attend an orientation/information session given by your child's school. If you haven't, contact the school's Parent Coordinator for information you may have missed.
- ✓ Attend a provider fair given by your child's school to learn more about the providers available for SES tutoring services.
- ✓ Complete the enrollment form and return it to the school's Parent Coordinator or your selected SES provider. (Make sure you have signed and dated the enrollment form.)
- ✓ Call or email your selected SES provider if you haven't heard from them regarding the start date, time and location for your child's tutoring within two weeks of your signature date.

At the time the tutoring sessions begin, the provider is required to develop your child's Student Education Plan. Please be sure to sign the plan and to get a copy. Progress reports are due quarterly once tutoring sessions begin.

### IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Please remember that you may select any approved provider listed in this guide and that you are not obligated to select the providers located in your child's school.
- Transportation is not provided.
- If you have any concerns about a provider and you are not able to resolve them with the provider, please contact the school's Parent Coordinator or Principal.
- If you remove/transfer your child from a NYC DOE SES eligible school, your child can no longer receive services and will be discharged from their SES program.
- If you re-enroll your child in an SES eligible school, you MUST re-enroll him/her in their SES Program before any additional SES services can be provided. (Please note, your child must be officially enrolled with their new SES eligible school. To ensure this, the parent/guardian needs to speak with the school before contacting the SES Program Office.)
- Do not complete more than one enrollment form for each SES eligible child. Only one SES program per child is permitted in any one school year.
- If you have more than one eligible child, you can select different providers.
- Attendance is important. Make sure your child attends the SES program that you have selected.
