- Provide information, professional development, and training on the referral, assessment, and provision of instruction to students in inclusive settings.
- Offer professional development and on site coaching to schools that have inclusive classroom settings such as Integrated Co-Teaching (ICT).
- Collaborate with contracted partners in order to provide high quality services to schools and teachers.
- Provide training to Children First Network instructional staff.
- Assist with program development.
- Attend conferences, professional development, and training as required.


