

Number of Students Taking and Passing AP Exams


Number of Students Taking At Least 1 AP Exam




NYC's SAT Participation

The number of high school seniors who took the SAT at least once




SAT Scores by Subject for NYC, the Nation and the Rest of New York State








SAT Scores by Subject by Ethnicity












PSAT Scores by Ethnicity


