2 FEMALE VOICE: The proposal of grade
3 expansion of District 75 programs from grade 5
4 to grade 8 at new building R071 beginning in
5 2013-2014 school year. Today is April 9, 2013,
6 and we're at R373. Principle Monoluca
7 [phonetic] is out with us tonight. However,
8 Principle of 373 Irene Goldstein Parment
9 [phonetic]. Her assistant principle Mary Ann
10 [phonetic] McNamara [phonetic] is with us and
11 our CC representatives Mike Reilly, Primel
12 [phonetic] Keishe [phonetic], SLT - - Royal
13 Cause United - - 628 is not with us today.
14 Orica [phonetic] from Peak 373 and R048 is
15 welcome. Welcome - -

16 FEMALE VOICE 2: Good evening. This is
17 joint public hearing on the Department of
18 Education for the education council and school
19 leadership team proposed grade expansion of
20 District 75 program day-to-day at new building
21 R071. Beginning in 2013-2014 school year, IU
22 District 31 superintendent - -. We have asked
23 the district lead 31 newly education council and
24 school leadership teams of P48 and P373R to
25 participate in this joint public hearing. Once

1 again, we have from the PR48, P373R, and R48 we
2 have Maria Cafaro [phonetic] and we have a
3 school leadership team of - - and - - we can get
4 our principle Irene Goldstein Parment and our
5 assistant principle Mary Ann McNamara. This
6 hearing is being recorded. The purpose of this
7 hearing is deemed to provide comments about the
8 polls. Before I describe what the polls, I want
9 to make sure you are all very - - to provide - -
10 all those who wish to speak must sign up in the
11 speaker sign up area located outside the
12 auditorium. The sign up list will close in 15
13 minutes. Speakers will be given the floor in
14 the order that they signed up. All comments are
15 limited to this. There may be less - - at
16 different times throughout the evening. If they
17 wish to speak, we will do our best to
18 accommodate them at the first opportune moment.
19 Those who are here at the start of the public
20 comment segment will be asked to speak first.
21 All comments will be mentioned in the analysis
22 of public comment to be published and provided
23 to the Title Club for educational policy that
24 the evening before the panel votes. That vote
25 is scheduled April 17, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. at

1 Costa [phonetic] Heights campus located at 883
2 Clausen Avenue, Brooklyn, New York, 11225. In
3 addition, we welcome any comment and feedback
4 you may have at any time before the panel votes
5 on both proposals. The email address and the
6 phone numbers where comments may be made are
7 d31proposalsa@schools.nyc.gov and the phone
8 number is (212)374-7621. Okay. The proposal
9 summary is the New York City Department of
10 Education is proposing to expand P373R at PS48R.
11 A District 75 school is opening in 2013-2014 in
12 the new building located at 1050 Targous
13 [phonetic] Street, Staten Island, New York
14 10304, the community school district 31. On
15 June 26, 2012, the panel for educational policy
16 pep arrived--approved - - the proposal to
17 resight, expand, and co-locate PS48 William C.
18 Wilcox a sole elementary school that current
19 serves students in kindergarten through fifth
20 grade with P373R at PS48 a new District 75
21 school that was initially projected to serve
22 students in kindergarten through fifth grade in
23 the new building in the 2013-2014 school year.
24 A co-location means that two or more school
25 organizations are located in the same building,

1 often sharing large common spaces like
2 auditoriums, gymnasiums, and cafeteria. This
3 proposal implements a grade expansion whereby
4 P373R and PS48 will expand to serve students in
5 kindergarten through eighth grades when it opens
6 in the 2013-2014 school year in the new
7 building. This will provide District 75
8 families with greater access to middle school
9 options in Stanton Island and will align P373R
10 and PS48 grade span. According to the school's
11 construction authority, the SCA, the new
12 building is projected to have the capacity to
13 serve 844 students. P373R and PS48 are
14 projected to serve approximately 62-72 students
15 in grades kindergarten through eighth in the
16 2015-2016 school year. PS48's kindergarten
17 through fifth grade students will be resighted
18 to the new building for the 2013-2014 school
19 year with the sixth grade cohort. During the
20 2013-2014 school year, these organizations will
21 serve approximately 720 to 800 students yielding
22 a projected building utilization rate of 85
23 percent to 95 percent. In the 2015-2016 school
24 year, when PS48 has reached full scale serving
25 students in grades kindergarten through eighth

1 and pre-kindergarten there will be a total of
2 approximately 910 to 1,010 students yielding the
3 projected building utilization for both
4 organizations of 108 percent to 120 percent.
5 The proposed grade expansion does not change the
6 plan enrollment or space requirements with the
7 P373R and PS48 which was based on the SCA's
8 recorded District 75 design to seek capacity in
9 the new building. Thank you. The next
10 presenter will be. Well, tonight we have no one
11 commenting. See season agreement and our school
12 district team is already in agreement so I want
13 to thank you and we have now concluded the
14 formal presentation. We will now open the floor
15 for public comments. Speakers will be given the
16 floor in the order they signed up. All comments
17 are limited to two minutes. Okay, we have no
18 speakers. Okay, again we welcome any comments
19 and defense you may have at any time before the
20 panel for educational policy votes on this
21 proposed proposal at its April 17 meeting.


