AMENDMENTS TO CHANCELLOR'S REGULATION A-420—CORPORAL PUNISHMENT

I. Description of the subject and purpose of the proposed item under consideration.

Chancellor's Regulation A-420 defines and prohibits the use of corporal punishment upon a student. The Regulation is being amended to clarify and revise the definition of corporal punishment, revise and clarify procedures for reporting corporal punishment, institute new procedures for School-Based investigations, clarify the investigative process, clarify when witness statements may be released to the accused employee, and clarify that employees who violate the regulation will be subject to discipline or appropriate follow-up action.
